MEMORIAL DAY - What It Means

Every Military Headstone has a Story ~ This Memorial Day we remember the more than one million men and women who have died in U.S. military service. We dedicate the last Monday in May to their memory, while acknowledging that for our Gold Star families, the mourning is not limited to 24 hours per year.

We benefit from fallen Americans' sacrifices every time we exercise our constitutional rights. We are able to speak freely, peaceably assemble and vote. Public officials don't secure us these rights. Rather, they have been paid for in blood by those who willingly risked their lives to protect ours, from the founding of our nation to today. As the saying goes, "All gave some and some gave all."

From the world wars to Korea, from Vietnam to the Middle East and Afghanistan, every US military headstone has a story and everyone is inspirational in its own way. Together they bear witness to the selflessness described in John 15:13 "Greater love has no one than this to lay down one's life for one's friends." (Paul E. 84 Year History of the Memorial Day Ceremony at Loma Vista Memorial Park ~ What began as a small effort in 1939 by the Chapman family decorating 47 graves is now over 400 volunteers on the Saturday morning before Memorial Day placing the flags and crosses, or Stars of David, on over 4,400 graves. Volunteers get a personal sense of accomplishment when they see the beauty of the cemetery that has been transformed into a field of flags and crosses. They also gain a greater appreciation for the sacrifices of the men and women who served in the armed forces. Many people return every year and bring their families to volunteer including some three-generation families. In 2020 and 2021, Covid-19 limited attendance to just a few to have a brief ceremony with a flag and cross for each service near the flagpole and making flags available for those who visited their loved ones over the weekend. About 500 families took advantage of this.

The sole mission of American Veterans Memorial Association (AVMA) is to sustain the annual Memorial Day services held at Loma Vista Memorial Park, Fullerton, California, at which a cross, or star of David, and a flag are placed on the grave of each service man or woman in memory of his or her dedication to the cause of freedom. This mission began in 1939 by **C. Stanley Chapman**, grandson one of the Fullerton founding families, and has continued every year. The vision is to maintain it as the premier Memorial Day ceremony in Orange County. From 1955 -1979 Fullerton American Legion Post 142 member **Les Clever**, a retired USAF Master Sergeant, led the program using his entire garage for storage. The AVMA was formed in 1982 by **A.B. "Buck" Catlin**, retired USN Submarine Commander and Mayor, to provide a continuing organization dedicated to sustaining the mission. Buck led the program until 2008 and then assumed the position of Chairman until his passing at age 98 in 2016. **Ed Paul** has led the program since 2008.

Our Speaker ~ Brigadier General David G. Smith is the Special Assistant to the Commanding General, California State Guard (CSG), California Military Department, where he supports Title 32 actions for the readiness, effectiveness and integration of the CSG with the California Army and Air National Guard. Additionally, he is the Director of the multi-billion dollar Air Force Production and Flight Test Facility, Plant 42.

General Smith entered the Air Force in 1982, and flew B-52's at multiple locations. His many accomplishments include earning the coveted Fairchild Trophy; an achievement recognized by President Reagan. He was hand-picked from all B-52,

B-1 and FB-111 crews to accompany General Chain, CINCSAC, to represent the SAC alert force receiving the David C. Schilling Award for the year's most outstanding contribution to flight. He has also served as a Regimental Air Liaison Officer attached to the elite 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment. He has deployed to combat duty in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. General Smith is married to the former Denise Cook, and they share six children, a son Damien, and daughters, Daira, Darcie, Avalon, Bailee, and Madyson, along with seven grandchildren.
