COVID-19 Update

Good afternoon from Midway Nursing Home -

There are no changes to yesterday's update. All resident and staff testing for COVID-19 continues to be negative and no residents are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19

All residents continue to be on precautionary isolation until November 6th. This is out of an abundance of caution and is consistent with CDC & NYSDOH guidance for nursing home residents.

Virtual visits are available daily. Please contact Social Services or Recreation to set this up.

We anticipate that limited visitation will resume next Monday, November 9th. All visits must be scheduled in advance according to the unit the resident resides on. All visitors are required to be screened and present a negative COVID-19 PCR test result that was conducted within 7 days prior to the visit. Visitors are limited to 2 per resident and must be 18 years or older.

COVID still remains active and has not gone away. Please continue to always wear a mask when you are out, wash or sanitize your hands frequently and monitor yourself for symptoms.
