

Race to Count the Hearts Games

Materials Needed:

- 1. Small Clear Plastic Cups
- 2. Small Hearts to Put in the Cups (ex. –small heart erasers, heart candies, paper hearts, etc.)
- 3. Number Die or Pair of Dice

Object of Game:

Players take turns rolling the die and then counting out hearts to match the number on the die.

After all of the hearts have been counted and placed into the cups, each player takes turns counting their total hearts to see who has the most. The player with the most hearts wins or the first player to fill their cup wins.

- 2. Anyone with repeated vomiting or diarrhea without a fever needs to stay home 24 hours without symptoms before returning to school.
- 3. If your child has excessive coughing or congestion, we encourage you to keep them home until the coughing and congestion subsides.

Changes to the COVID-19 Guidelines in Preschools and Childcares

Due to the recent changes in the CDC and Elkhart County Health Dept. guidelines for upper respiratory disease and COVID-19, the Goshen Day Care Board has decided to update the COVID policies at Walnut Hill ECC. Starting Monday, February 28, 2022, maskwearing will be optional for all employees and family members. Extra masks will still be supplied in the lobby for those who want to continue to wear a


mask while in our building. In addition, we will no longer close classrooms for potential close contact or exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID. We will still inform families of children who have been in close contact with a COVID positive individual, but it will be up to the families to decide whether they want to keep their child in quarantine due to the possible exposure or send them to school. However, we may have to close a classroom if we have a staff shortage due to illness. We will continue to clean and sanitize the classrooms daily and practice hand washing throughout the day as required by State Licensing and as a preventive measure against spreading germs. We ask that families help us prevent the spread of germs as well by continuing to monitor their children for symptoms of illness and continuing to keep them home when symptoms are present. Please continue to follow our sick policy as outlined in the beginning of this newsletter.
