



## Talk

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt.

6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30) and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight

(Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

As a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up you and your entire house to the Father, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Grace to you and your house and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We thank our God, making mention of you in our prayers that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus. (Philem. 1:3-6) Hear our prayer, O God; give ear to the words of our mouth. (Ps. 54:2) In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours will capture all of your thoughts and all of your words and put them under the obedience of Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 10:5), who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30). Let the Lord set a guard over your mouths; keep watch over the doors of your lips (Ps. 141:3), and the Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) your tongues to be of choice silver (Prov. 10:20). Let the God of your salvation (Ps. 25:5) help you guard your mouth and tongue and keep your souls from trouble (Prov. 21:23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray no corrupt communication will proceed out of your mouth (Eph. 4:29) that will defile your heart (Matt. 15:11), but what is good for necessary edification (Eph. 4:29). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), in whom new creation avails (Gal. 6:15), out of the abundance of your hearts let your mouth speak (Matt. 12:34) blessings (James 3:10) and

life (Acts 5:20), speaking with tongues of men and of angels in love (1 Cor. 13:1). May you and your house not be undone because you are people of unclean lips. (Is. 6:5) Let the seraphim of God touch your lips with live coal from the altar of God that your iniquity be taken away, and your sin purged. (Is. 6:6-7) In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), as the truth is in Him (Eph. 4:21), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of truth (Ps. 31:4, Deut. 32:4) to teach you and your family to guard your mouth and preserve your life (Prov. 13:3), lest you sin with your tongues (Ps. 39:1). Let all evil speaking be put away from you and your people (Eph. 4:31), with flattering lips (Ps. 12:2), great swelling words (Jude 1:16), and the tongue that speaks proud things (Ps. 12:3). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will walk uprightly, work righteousness, speak truth in your hearts (Ps. 15:2), stir up love and good works (Heb. 10:24), exhorting one another (Heb. 10:25), not backbiting with your tongues, nor doing evil to your neighbors, nor taking up a reproach against your friends (Ps. 15:3). Instead you will be followers of God as dear children. And walk in love, as **Christ** also has loved you and given Himself for you, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. (Eph. 5:12) For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea. (Hab. 2:14) God, the Holy One, His glory covers the heavens, and the earth is full of His praise. (Hab. 3:3)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of all flesh (Jer. 32:27) to help you and your family keep your tongues from evil and your lips from speaking deceit (Ps. 34:13). Let you and your house speak with truthful lips (Prov. 12:19) and a gentle (Prov. 25:15) wholesome tongue (Prov. 15:4), your words being gracious (Eccl. 10:12). Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt. (Col. 4:6) In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the bread of life (John 6:48), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father that your

heart will teach your mouth and add learning to your lips. (Prov. 16:23) Let you and your people guard the doors of your mouth (Mic. 7:5, Ps. 141:3), and not be hasty in your words (Prov. 29:20), never speaking idle words (Matt. 12:36), always being wise (Prov. 13:20) in who you trust or put your confidence in (Mic. 7:5), being people of few words (Eccl. 5:3), giving thought to all of your answers (Prov. 15:28), never murmuring, complaining (Jude 1:16), disputing (Phil. 2:14-15), grumbling, or fault finding (Jude 1:16). For God, who commanded light to shine out of darkness, has shined in your heart, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of *Jesus Christ*. (2 Cor. 3:6) The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the true Light (John 1:9), according to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father to let your words be of wisdom and justice (Ps. 37:30), with stored up wisdom, knowledge, and understanding (Prov. 10:13-14). The Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) you and yours to have a learned well trained disciples tongue (Is. 50:4), from the counsel of God (Ps. 16:7); the meditation of your heart bringing understanding (Ps. 49:3), and a mouth of wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist (Luke 21:15). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father of Lights (James 1:17) to open to you and your house a door for the word, to speak the mystery of **Christ** (Col. 4:3). May the Lord put His words in your mouth and cover you and your house with the shadow of His hand. (Is. 51:16) In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray the Lord be with your mouth and teach you and your people what you shall say. (Ex. 4:12) In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), for of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever (Rom. 11:36), in His name in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray the words of your mouth and the meditations of your heart will be acceptable in God's

sight (Ps. 19:14). By your words you and yours will be justified. (Matt. 12:37) Let you and your people be satisfied from the fruit of your mouth; from the produce of your lips. (Prov. 18:20) In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), according to His loving kindness (Ps. 119:88), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of truth (Ps. 31:5, Deut. 32:4, Is. 65:16) to give you and your people a mouth of wisdom (Luke 21:15), and precious lips of knowledge (Prov. 20:15). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Lord of glory (James 2:1), the words from your mouth shall be deep waters; the wellspring of wisdom a flowing brook (Prov. 18:4). May your mouths be filled with laughter (Ps. 126-2) and joy (Prov. 15:23), your tongues with singing (Ps. 126-2), confessing that Jesus Christ is Lord, giving glory to God the Father (Phil. 2:11). Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised. The Lord is high above all nations, and His glory above the heavens. Who is like the Lord our God, who dwells on high, who humbles Himself to behold the things that are in the heavens and in the earth? (Ps. 113:2-6) Praise the name of the Lord!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), Himself being the chief cornerstone (Eph. 2:20), the Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:16) that you and yours will see the glory of God (Acts 7:55); and with all boldness you and your family will speak His word (Acts 4:29), for it is not you that speak but the Holy Spirit (Mark 13:11). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people go from strength to strength (Ps. 84:7); and walk in the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31); serving Christ in these things; and are acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18).

According to all that the Lord has bestowed on you and your people, and the great goodness toward your house, which He has bestowed on you according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of truth (Ps. 31:4, Deut. 32:4) meet you and

your house and speak to you (Ex. 29:42); that you and your family will hear what the Lord God will speak, for He will speak peace to you and your people (Ps. 85:8-9). In ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will obey His voice and do all that He speaks. (Ex. 23:22) Let you and your house speak His testimonies and not be ashamed. (Ps. 119:46) Let your lips speak right things (Prov. 23:16) and your tongue speak of His word, for all of His commandments are righteousness (Ps. 119:172). May you and your house praise His works, to all generations and declare His mighty acts. (Ps. 145:4) Let you and your children speak of the might of His awesome acts and declare His greatness and utter the memory of His great goodness and sing of His righteousness (Ps. 145:6-7) for His tender mercies are over all His works (Ps. 145:9). May you and your house bless the Lord your God and speak of the glory of His kingdom and talk of His power, to make known to your children and your children's children His mighty acts and the glorious majesty of His kingdom. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom and His dominion endures throughout all generation. (Ps. 145:10-13). Let the Lord be magnified, Who has pleasure in the posterity of your house. (Ps. 35:27)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17, 19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), ***Jesus Christ***, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all

things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed,

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) we ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him

void but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it. His name shall endure forever; His name shall continue as long as the sun. And men shall be blessed in Him; all nations shall call Him blessed. Blessed be the Lord God, the God of Israel, who only does wondrous things! And blessed be His glorious name forever! And let the whole earth be filled with His glory. (Ps. 72:17-20) For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
