1. NO FOOD ITEMS NEEDING REFRIDGERATION.
2. All pies to be made in 4" (10cm) pie plates, except for "SPECIAL" classes where regular size pies are to be entered.
3. Food is to be exhibited on small plates and in plastic bags, not plastic wrap. Unless specified, only one-half loaf of bread is to be entered, unless entered in a "SPECIAL" class. No plates needed for any bread unless in a "SPECIAL".
4. **No commercial mixes and or purchased pre-made products. Exhibit must be completely home made.**
