HURRICANE/TROPICAL STORM SUPPLEMENT
FOR
HERONWOOD HOMEOWNERS

BACKGROUND

As a Community of individually owned homes, each of us has the responsibility for caring for our property. In the event of a Hurricane or severe Tropical Storm, each resident or their contractor must clear his/her own property. Our garbage collector, Waste Management, has, in writing, limited what they will remove to:

"No larger than four feet long and four inches around"

NEW RULES

1. Yard waste, too large for Waste Management, must be placed on the front 25% of your driveway, which will permit access to your garage.
2. IN NO CASE CAN WE PLACE YARD WASTE IN THE STORM GUTTER AREA OF OUR ROADS OR ATOP THE SEWER DRAIN.
3. Additional yard waste must be placed on your lawn. Sod is much less expensive than flood damage.
4. Those in residence on our 11 Cul de Sacs may place waste on the "entry" end, as long as the street is not blocked for auto and large truck traffic. The Cul de Sac plantings are much less expensive than flood damage.

WE MOST CERTAINLY HOPE THAT WE WILL HAVE NO MORE SERIOUS STORMS AFFECTING HERONWOOD, BUT IF WE DO, YOUR COOPERATION IS ABSOLUTELY VITAL.
