Items for Resident Intake

The following is a list of items that will be needed/allowed for residents to enter program. Please note that the items listed for clothing is the limit that will be allowed, if excess is brought it must be returned.

Clothing

Pants/Shorts: A TOTAL of 10 bottom garments are allowed. This can consist of jeans, casuals, and shorts. Any assortment of the above. Please consider in your assortment that we attend church and outside meetings where pants must be clean and neat. (No holes or tears) –and we will be on occasion working outside.

Shirts: A TOTAL of 12 shirts will be allowed. This can consist of T-Shirts, Polo’s, or button up. Please consider that we will attend meetings where collars are required, and we will occasionally work outside.

Shoes: A TOTAL of 4 pairs of shoes will be allowed. This can consist of dress, tennis, and work shoes. Included in this number must be at least 1 pair of shower shoes/flip flops for bathroom use.

Undergarments: A TOTAL of 10 pair of underwear is allowed. (Boxer or Brief) – A TOTAL of 10 pair of sox is allowed.

Miscellaneous: Residents will be allowed to have a TOTAL of 2 pajama/sleep outfits.
Residents will be allowed to have a TOTAL of 2 Jackets (Light/Heavy)

Personal Items

*Residents need to bring all personal items such as Towels, washcloths (max 5 each), soap, shampoo, razors, shave cream, electric razor, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc... *No mouthwash with alcohol allowed or hand sanitizer.

*Paper, pens, pencils, stamps, envelopes should also be considered. Please keep these to a minimum in quantity. Also, a small reading lamp will be allowed, preferably with clip.

*Only reading material that is Biblically or Recovery related will be allowed. Please keep to a minimum.

***NO cell phones or any internet connecting devices are allowed. No exceptions.**

***Please consider that you will be sharing a room with other residents. Storage space will be limited**
