2. This team is the place where Rev. Christy can receive feedback about potential changes in worship or church programming before he makes them.
3. It focuses its work on the first ninety to one hundred days of the transition and disbands after the pastor and the team mutually agree that they have reached the breakeven point, or end of the transition.
