PROJECT HOPE

The Chapstick Hotel Outreach in West Palm Beach has completed its third outreach. So far, we have gone to 13 hotels and distributed chapsticks and posters of missing children. At one hotel, the desk worker recognized one of the missing children on the flyer and was confident that the girl had been at that hotel a few days before. We were able to call in this tip to National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. In addition, one of the hotels has requested a hotel training on Human Trafficking for their employees.

We are planning to launch the project in the South County area in January, 2018. In the interim, If you want to be trained as to what to do and what to say to the people at the front desk of various motels and hotels (most of our South County program visits will be in Delray and Lake Worth), we ask that you attend a training session from 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm, on Sunday, September 17 or November 12th, 2017, at Shoppe 561, on Dixie Highway in West Palm Beach, and then continue on for an hour or two to become familiar with our actual program.

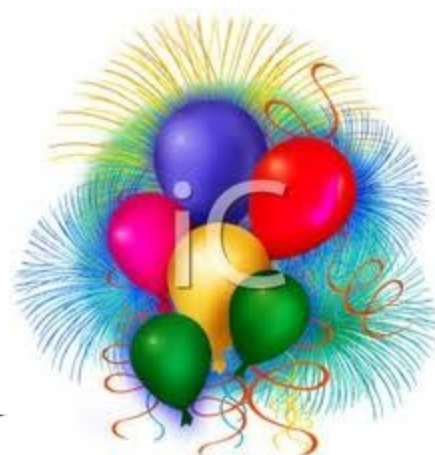

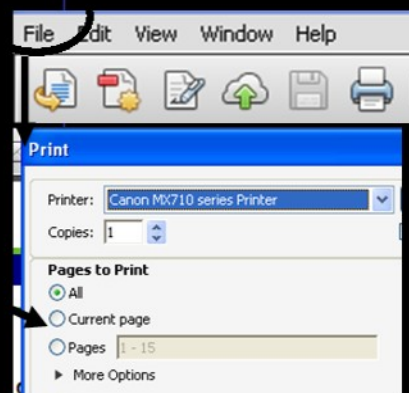

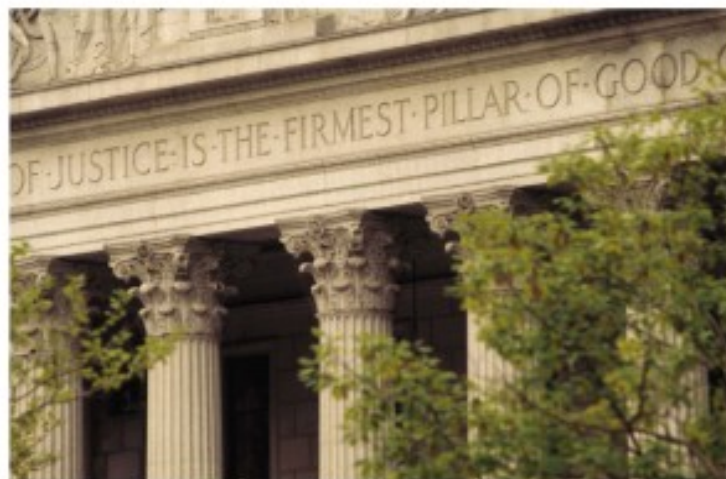

HURRICANE HARVEY– A PERSONAL PERSPECTIVE

I'd like to share some thoughts about the effects of Hurricane Harvey on Houston Texas. My daughter, Caryn, son-in-law, Ben, and toddler Aviva live in Houston. They have been among the fortunate as their home remains dry, and they have power and running water. However, they have watched helicopters rescue neighbors only two blocks away as this storm ripped through all sections of the city.

As for the Jewish community, which is huge, I am glad to report that all the Torahs in the city's congregations have been saved. On the other hand, Caryn and Ben's conservative congregation, Beth Yeshurun, one of the largest in the United States, has sustained significant damage and will not be usable for the High Holidays. The rabbi's home as well has been significantly damaged. The leadership states that, "Sadly, even though we had "only" 8 inches of water throughout the entire building, the beautiful wood paneling we have throughout and the matching wood doors are warped and have to be replaced. That will all take some time. All the seats in the sanctuaries have to be removed to be cleaned and possibly replaced. All of our offices have to be rebuilt. We may be displaced out of the synagogue for some period of time. "

The Houston JCC, a large and vibrant facility, has also sustained tremendous damage. For example, their daycare for children has been suspended. Those who depend on their pre-school and toddler care in order to work are scrambling to find alternatives. The JCC is also beginning the heartbreaking process of drying up and ripping out carpeting, drywall, and furniture. They cannot begin to anticipate the scope of what needs to be done until their power is restored.

While it is heartbreaking to live through such a monumental tragedy, Caryn and Ben report that they have seen the very best that humanity can offer in the outpouring of assistance to and from every corner of the city.
