ANIMALS AT THE PROPERTIES

Tenants are responsible for ensuring their animals have been approved by management as outlined in your lease agreement, and the tenant has received an approved Pet/Animal Request/Registration form from management. <u>VIS-ITING ANIMALS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY!</u>

Animals must be on a leash and in control <u>at all times</u>! It is prohibited to tie an animal to an entry door, tree(s), light post, etc.

Animals must relieve themselves at a spot that is away from ALL buildings. Tenants should not use "puppy pads" or allow dogs to relieve themselves inside!

Pet waste must be picked up immediately! Not later in the day, week or month!

Once you have purchased a portable floor model air conditioner, please contact the management office to schedule a time for a maintenance person to measure your window and air conditionler vent. Management will have a piece of plexiglass cut and
