



### Julv

**Informal Portrait in True Black & White** - An informal facial portrait executed in true Black & White, i.e. not color, not monochrome.

### September

**Recreation at a State or National Park** - People enjoying recreational activities at any state or national park. Include a recognizable landmark in your image. Color. B&W or Monochrome.

### **November**

**Fall Color in the Landscape** - An image of Fall color in the natural world (meaning the world that does not show the handiwork of humans). Color only. For obvious reasons.


