INDIA MISSION TEAM—At this writing, all are well. Please continue to pray.

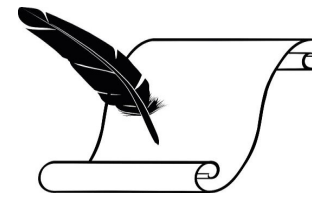
