

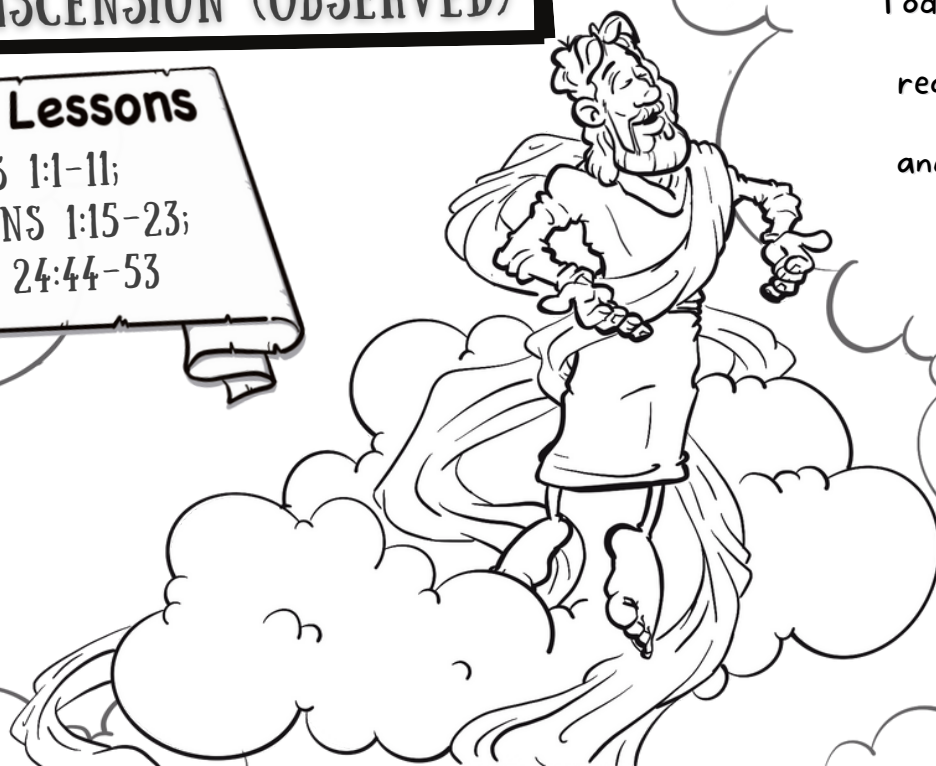

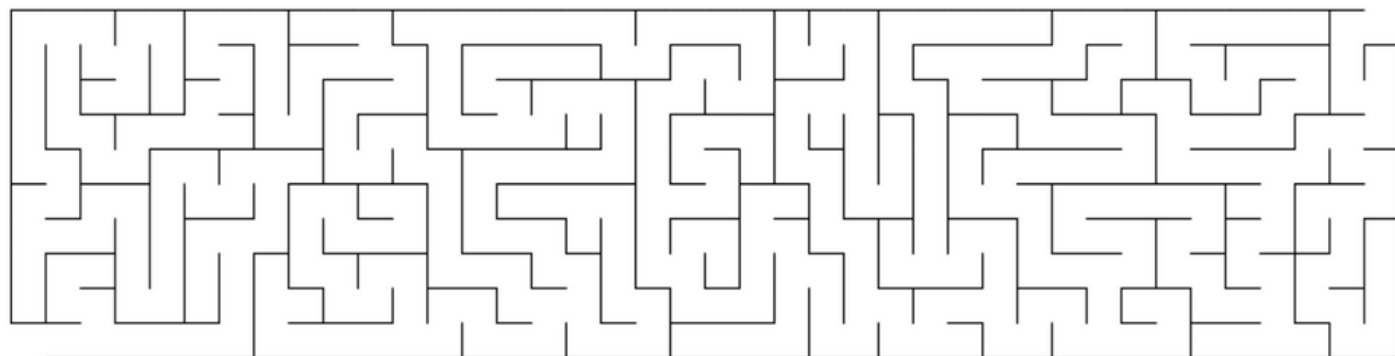
Bible Lessons
