As we prepare our younger dancers to go on the big stage it is just as helpful for parents to talk with them about it at home so they are fully prepared and understand that they will be performing for a crowd of people! We like to avoid stage fright as much as possible! Please talk with them about how much fun it is to perform and show everything they have been working so hard on all year!

Reictal Helpers Needed!

This year we are looking for our older students ages 12 + to help us with our 10:30 and 1:00 recitals. We need as many helpers as we can get! We especially need help with the 10:30 show as we are trying to allow parents the opportunity to sit and enjoy the show, rather than running back and forth. We have a sign-up sheet at studio A! We will assign all helpers a job as the day approaches! Thank you in advance!

How will the recitals work???

Our plan for this year is to have parents help as little as possible so they can sit and enjoy the show. Of course if you would prefer to be in charge of your child you are welcome to do so! Also, AS MUCH AS WE LOVE FATHERS ©, with the majority of our students being girls we ask that fathers stay away from the changing areas. Thank you in advance!!

10:30 Show:

We will be assigning student volunteers and teachers to classes. Students will be waiting in the hallway 5 numbers prior to when they go on stage. In the mean time they will remain in the dressing areas with their helpers along with some entertainment ©. Our helpers and teachers will be helping students get changed from their first costume into their second costume when the time comes. To help the process we are going to assign an animal to each class so that the class can put their costume and dance bags in the assigned area of the dressing room. This way we will be able to locate their belongings. Please label all items including, costumes, tights, and shoes. This will help us stay organized. If a parent would prefer to change their child please feel free to come backstage and change them immediately after they dance. If you are ok with our process then please feel free to relax and enjoy the show!

At the end of the show all students will be in their tap shoes so that they can perform our studio wide tap warm up as a finale! We have tried to make this process simple by making the majority of our dances ballet in the first half of the show and tap in the second half, with the exception of a couple of kindy/1st classes. After the finale 1 parent should come backstage to meet their students at their assigned dressing area. It gets very crowded to please only 1 parent. Thank you! We will be running dress rehearsal in this exact same manner so please drop them off backstage and feel free to have a seat! Of course if they have to get a picture taken feel free to come get them ©

1:00 Show:

The majority of our Level 1 and 2 students are in multiple dances. This means that they will be changing back stage and may not have much time for going into the audience. We are leaving the back left 2 rows of the auditorium blocked off for students who are not in multiple dances, but for the most part students will remain backstage. Parents are welcome to come back and change their own children, but we will also assign student helpers to the backstage dressings areas so that they can help students change in addition to keeping them entertained and out of trouble ©
