### **J. André Séguin, OMM, CD 08 April 1939 – 16 May 2013**

André Séguin was a Member of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping and was a Member of the Colonel John Gardam Chapter, Ottawa, Ontario. André joined the Royal Canadian Army (Militia) in October 1954, and then joined the Royal Canadian Army (Regular) as a soldier apprentice with the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps in June 1955. André later became a commissioned officer and a helicopter pilot. Among his career accomplishments he commanded 408 Squadron. André Séguin served with the United Nations Transition Assistance Group (Namibia) (UNTAG) during 1988 - 1989, also in 1990. He also completed 2 tours with the United Nations Multinational Force and Observers (Sinai) during 1987 and 1991. He was a member of the recce team that examined facilities for insertion of a UN force into Western Sahara and was the first to use GPS technology on such a recce. André was also a member of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 638, Kanata, Ontario, the Royal Canadian Army Service Corp Apprentice Soldiers Association and the Friends of the Canadian War Museum
