

Renewed Mind Declarations
(to be said out loud)

Father God I submit myself and my children fully to You and declare these things in Jesus' name on my behalf and theirs. Please fulfill Your word and establish them in us and our lives in fullness without delay. I trust and have faith that You will. Thank you, I love You, Amen.

I turn all of our burdens, worries and fears over to Father God and He will take care of us. He is for us and will never let us stumble. We have His righteousness through our faith in Jesus Christ. (Psalm 55:2; Romans 3:21-22)

The Spirit God gave us is not a spirit of fear, but of power, love, a sound mind and self-control. (2 Timothy 1:7)

God transforms us by renewing our minds so that we may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. We believe that every word of God is true and we thank you God for our faith, for your faithfulness and for always fulfilling your promises. (Romans 12:2; Titus 1:2; Proverbs 30:5)

God's perfect love in us casts out all fear from us. God is love and so are we because of Him. (1 John 4:18, 8)

God is with us wherever we go; He will never leave us nor forsake us. He upholds us in His hand. (Joshua 1:9; Deuteronomy 31:6; Isaiah 41:10)

God defends us, provides for all of our needs, protects us, does not let anything or anyone harm us, teaches us, heals us, delivers us, frees us, grows, matures and strengthens us, counsels us, guides us and directs us. He is our all in all and our everything and we delight in Him, seek Him, love and cling to Him, trust Him, have faith in Him, adore Him, thank Him, worship and praise Him – for He alone is worthy. God is good and He works all things together for good for us, His children. He has a perfect plan for us and will give us everything we need to fully accomplish it, to be content no matter what circumstances we face, and to glorify Him and advance His Kingdom, which is our Kingdom. (Nahum 1:7; Romans 8:28; Jeremiah 29:11; 2 Corinthians 9:8; Matthew 6:33; Philippians 4:12)

We lean on Father God only, and not on anyone or anything else, including our own understanding. Father God is in control and we trust Him fully with our eternal lives because He is trustworthy – He always tells the truth and He never lies. His truth sets us free. (Proverbs 3:5; Titus 1:2; Proverbs 30:5; John 8:32)

There is never a reason to be anxious or afraid because God is for us and nothing or no one can stand against us. (Philippians 4:6; Romans 8:31; Isaiah 41:10)

The perfect peace and joy of Jesus dwell within us and with God there is no reason for us to be dismayed, troubled or shaken. He is our Rock and will not allow us to stumble, fall or our feet to be moved. We are strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. (Isaiah 26:3; John 14:27; 15:11; Psalm 144:1-2; 18; Ephesians 6:10)

Rivers of God's living water flow in us and through us and we flow wherever He leads us. (John 7:38; 3:8)

We are new creations in Jesus Christ and have died to the flesh and its sin nature. We are forgiven, clean, redeemed and reconciled to Father God. The powers of darkness have no power, authority, control or influence over us. We walk in the fullness of Christ's victory and will for all eternity. (2 Corinthians 5:17; John 15:3; Colossians 2:13-15)

By Jesus we are healed. Our bodies are made healthy and our minds are made sound – disease and sickness have no power over us, cannot touch us and we reject, renounce and rebuke them in all their forms. (Isaiah 53:5; Colossians 2:13-15)

We are the temple of almighty God and were made in His image. He perfects us to the measure of the stature of the fullness of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ with whom we are already one. By Him, we have abundance and fullness of eternal life and are being taken from glory to glory and further transformed into His likeness. (2 Corinthians 6:16; Genesis 1:27; Ephesians 4:13; John 17:21; John 10:10; 2 Corinthians 3:18)

The LORD is our shepherd. In Him alone, we have everything we could ever need. He gives us rest, causing us to lie down in green pastures. He leads us to and causes to walk beside calm and peaceful waters. He renews our strength. He guides us along right paths, bringing honor to His name.
