## County Planning Department


Our thanks to Peter Maurer for attending the meeting to provide an update on the Calaveras County Planning Department.

The primary duty of the Planning Department is to work on proposed subdivisions and projects, and Peter said that projects have been slow in coming before the department.

His advised that his personal goal for the near future is to move the General Plan toward approval by the end of next year. They are currently in the last leg of the Environmental Impact Report, and they are working on the Administrative draft of the plan in order to meet SEQUA requirements.

A new law requires that the plan have an *Environmental Justice* element. This includes looking at vehicle miles traveled, and other items that may affect the environment, and exposure to environmental elements for lower income residents.

In answer to questions, he advised that there were 117 building permits issued for new construction last year, and a significant number of those were for rebuilding in the Butte Fire area.
