South Carolina Coastal Seniors Quota Rules

Basis of Competition

- SCCS tournaments are individual medal play tournaments using a modified Stableford System for scoring.
- Scoring is on a hole by hole basis:
 - **1** point for double bogey;
 - **2** points for a bogey;
 - **3** points for par;
 - **4** points for a birdie; and
 - **5** points for an eagle.
 - **0** points for triple bogie.
- Par is **54** points.

Initial Quota – New Members

- 1. Developed based on your current Ghin index at the time of your first event
- 2. Tournament handicap calculated using the Ghin index based on the course rating and Slope of the SCCS course and tee box being played.
- 3. Your Quota will be your Tournament Handicap subtracted from 54.
- 4. After playing in one event your quota will be adjusted based on performance.

Quota Adjustment

- 1. Quota is determined based upon your previous performance in SCCS events and adjusted after each tournament.
- 2. Quota will go **up** 1 point for every 2 points scored over your quota (**maximum adjustment +4**). For example: differential of +5, results in a +2 adjustment.
- 3. Quota will go **down** 1 point for every 2 points scored under your quota (**maximum adjustment 2**). For example: a differential of -3, results in a -1 adjustment.
- 4. No change in Quota for +/- 1 or zero difference.
- 5. This is your new Quota for the next tournament.

Special Quota Adjustments

- 1. Changing Tee Box assignment
 - a. Based on the slope differential of the course being played.
 - b. Generally, +2 points are added to your Quota when you move up a tee box.
 - c. Tee box selections are confirmed at the beginning of each season: November
 - d. Tee box change is allowed **ONCE** during the season.
- 2. A "home course" adjustment may be made based on the discretion of the Tournament Director.
