The \$100,000 Princeton Young Jumper Championships 2018

Open to all 4, 5, 6, & 7 year-old PSJ Registered Young Jumpers

Registration: \$100 per horse until June 30, 2018. \$200 until PYJC closing date of entries. \$300 after PYJC closing date.

Eligibility: All young jumpers must provide USEF age verification with show entry.

*All PYJC registered young jumpers may show in any 1.30m or under professional classes at Princeton Show Jumping in 2018 for no class fee, no grounds fee, no ship in fee, no office fee, no EMT fee. *NOT including the Princeton Young Jumper Championship in October and classes restricted to Junior or Amateur riders.

Entries must pay any applicable USEF and USHJA fees. You must register young jumpers and provide USEF age verification prior to showing. Registration information can be found at princetonyoungjumper.com.

Prize Money: Registered PYJC horses showing for free will not receive prize money. Horses will be listed in all results and will be eligible for all awarded trophies, coolers, and ribbons. Young jumpers will be eligible for prize money by paying all normal show fees. You must indicate "paid" status to the show office prior to competing. The show office will assume all undeclared paid horses as a PYJC registered horse. Stalls are NOT included in this offer.

The Princeton Young Jumper Championships will once again be the highlight of the Fall Season for all Young Jumpers. Two divisions of classes will be offered. The Championship Division and The Corinthian Division (10cm lower than the Championship division for 5, 6, and 7 year-olds.) 4 year-olds will only be offered in the Championship division.

Any discrepancies or unforeseen conflicts within the rules will be decided by PSJ show management, whose decision will be final.

USEF Rated Class Specs

Amateur Owner Hunter: To be ridden by an Amateur Owner or an amateur member of the owner's family who is no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor. Leased horses are not eligible and multiple ownership is not permitted unless all members are of the same family. An amateur who rides for a person outside the family may not ride in a class restricted to amateur owner in the same shows. Amateur Owner rider may, however, ride for other exhibitors in under saddle classes and for other Amateur Owner who have more than one entry in the under saddle class.

A/O Hunter Classic: Designated first-round class. Second round approx. 33" to 3'6". Horse must have entered, shown and completed the course in 2 A-O Hunter classes over fences.

Junior Hunter 3'6": Open to horses over 14.2 hands and of any age not restricted by previous showing in any division and riders whom have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Any horse and rider combination entered in the Junior Hunter Division may not cross enter in to the Children's Hunter Division or Children's Hunter Pony Division. All horses showing in the Junior Hunter Division must have a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by USEF. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Fences 3'6".

Jr. Hunter Classic: Designated first-round classic. 2nd rnd. Horse must have entered, shown and completed the course in two Junior Hunter classes over fences at the same show.

Junior Hunter 3'3": Open to horses over 14.2 hands and of any age not restricted by previous showing in any division and riders whom have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Any horse and rider combination entered in the 3'3" Junior Hunter Division may not cross enter in to the Children's Hunter Division, Children's Hunter Pony Division, or any 3'6" Junior Hunter Division. All horses showing in the 3'3" Junior Hunter Division must have a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by USEF. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Fences 3'3".

Bit O'Straw/PEL Hunter Derby 2'6": Two-round classic with the option to do both rounds back-to-back. Fences 2'6". Riders must be juniors or amateurs. Horse or pony must have entered, shown and completed the course in two hunter classes over fences at the same show.

Children's Hunter: To be shown by a junior exhibitor. Riders on horses may not cross enter into class where fences exceed 3' at the same competition except (Children's Jumper, Pony Jumpers, USHJA National Derby, and Equitation classes that do not exceed 3'6'). Class may be split between horses and ponies if more than three in each section. May be combined with adult amateur hunter. To be run in accordance with USEF/USJHA Zone 2 Specifications. Fences 3' for Horses, 2'6" for Large ponies, 2' for Sm/Med ponies.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be shown by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors, who possess a valid current USEF Amateur Card. Ponies may be shown by adults; suitability to count. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed fence heights. To be run in accordance with USEF/USHJA Zone 2 specifications. May be combined with Children's hunter.

Low Adult: Open to horses & ponies ridden by an adult amateur exhibitor. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any class or division with fences 3' or higher.

NJPHA/NJHSA Schooling Hunter 2'6": Open to all horses & riders. Judged on performance & soundness emphasis on manners.

NJPHA/NJHSA Suitable Hunter 3': Open to all horses & riders. Judged on performance & soundness emphasis on manners.

USEF CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Children's/Adult Medal 2'6": Open to junior riders on horses or ponies and adult amateur riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height of 2'6' including a combination and two changes of direction after the first fence.

Children's Medal 2', 2'6", 3': Open to riders in children/adult hunter division. Fences 2' for small-medium ponies, fences 2'6" for large ponies, and fences 3' for horses/adults. May be split between ponies and horses if entries warrant. May be combined with PEL Adult Medal.

Adult Medal 3': Open to all adult amateurs. To be shown over a minimum of eight (8) fences at 3'. May be combined with the Ariat Adult Medal or the Marshall & Sterling Adult medal. May also be combined with PEL Children's Medal.

NHS 3'3" Medal: The NHS 3'3" Medal Class and Championship are open only to junior members of the USEF or Equine Canada who have not reached their 18th birthday in accordance with GR127 and who have never competed in any of the following National Equitation Finals with fences at 3'6": ASPCA Maclay Finals, US Medal Finals, USEF Talent Search (East or West), WIHS Equitation Classic Finals, Jump Canada Medal Finals or the North American Equitation Championship. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. A minimum of twelve (12) riders, if available, are required to show at a walk, trot and canter. The under saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. USEF Tests 1-18.

Pre-Child/Adult Jumpers - Fences .80m. No cross entry of horse into Low or High Child/ Adult Jumper.

The Low and High Children's/Adult Jumper divisions will be run in accordance to USEF and USHJA Zone 2 rules and specs.

Low Child/Adult Classic: The horse must have been entered in at least one other Low Child/Adult Jumper class at the same show. 10 to fill. Formal Attire Required.

High Child/Adult Classic: The horse must have been entered in at least one other High Child/Adult Jumper class at the same show. 10 to fill. Formal Attire Required.

No martingale restrictions at 1.30m or below if used in the conventional manner. Draw Reins/German Martingales: Draw reins and German Martingales may only be used when schooling or in classes with no prize money that are offered at 1.20m or below. Ponies may not be ridden by a Junior in draw reins or German martingales at any time. No other head set devices (chambon, etc.) are permitted in any class.

Classes with prize money need 10 to fill. Otherwise, class will run as a 100% Entry Fee Sweepstakes. Pays to 4 places: \$50%, \$30%, \$15%, \$5%. Sweepstakes classes need 6 to fill.

A. The following classes will follow the National Specifications found in the USEF Rule Book: Amateur Owner Hunter (3'3" and 3'6"), Junior Hunter (3'3" and 3'6")

- B. The sections below will follow the USHJA Zone Specifications:
- 1. Children's Hunter Pony, Children's Hunter Horse, Adult Amateur Hunter, Children's Jumper, Adult Amateur Jumper.
- C. The sections below will follow the specifications as listed:
- 1. Low Children's Hunter Horse a. Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. b. Cross Entry: Riders may not cross enter at the same competition into the Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter or any class/section where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception: 3'0" Equitation). c. Height of Fences: 2'6"
- 2. Low Adult Amateur Hunter a. Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. b. Cross Entry: Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception: 3'0" Equitation). c. Height of Fences: 2'6"
- 3. .90m Children/Adult Amateur Jumper a. Eligibility: Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior or adult riders. b. Cross Entry: Riders may not have competed in classes where fences exceed 1.05m. c. Height of Fences: 0.90m (2'11")

USHJA OUTREACH CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Mini Stirrup: Open to riders 10 years of age and under as of December 1st of the current show year who have not shown over fences at 2' or higher. Riders may not cross enter any other division except Mini Stirrup Hunter.

Short Stirrup: Open to riders 12 years of age and under as of December 1st of the current show year who have not shown over fences at 2' or higher. Riders may not cross enter divisions except Short Stirrup Hunter.

Beginner Rider: Open to any rider who has not shown over fences at 2' or higher. Fences 18". Trotting anywhere on course not to be penalized.

Beginner Hunter: Open to all horses & ponies ridden by riders of any age. Fences 18". Section A: Rider not to have shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specification is 2' or higher. Section B: Horse or pony not to have shown in a division where the fence height specification is 2' or higher. Riders in Sec. A May not cross enter into any other division except Beginner Equitation and Pleasure. Trotting anywhere on course not to be penalized.

Pleasure Horse or Pony: Open to all horses and ponies. To be shown in English tack at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance & soundness with emphasis on manners. No martingales permitted. The class may be split into two (2) separate Sections (horses & ponies) provided there are three (3) in each section.

Leadline - Open to children 6 years old and under. Exhibition only. No entry fee!



The Princeton Equestrian League is dedicated to providing high quality competitions for Hunter, Jumper and Equitation riders. The league provides an opportunity for riders to compete throughout the year and qualify for the prestigious Princeton Equestrian League National Finals October at Princeton Show Jumping in Skillman, NJ.

Rider must be a League member in order for points to count for year-end awards. Any horse shown by a member rider will earn points in the division. Rider membership must be received in the League Office or Horse Show Office by the completion of the show for points to count.

USEF/Princeton Show Jumping Rules & Regulations

- The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if entries so warrant. In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry before the start of the competition without being liable for compensation.
- 2. All Prize money will be distributed 30%-22%-15%-12%-11%-10% unless otherwise specified.
- 3. Championships will be offered in all sections and be calculated at 10-6-4-2-1-.5 for hunters. Jumpers will be 10-6-4-2-1-.5 except the final class will be 15-9-6-3-2-1 with the bonus class breaking all ties.
- 4. Prize money will be applied to the exhibitor's outstanding account if any, or mailed to the exhibitor as listed on the entry blank within 30 days of the close of the show provided a W9 has been completed and is on file in the show office showing the taxpayer for each horse. Checks void after 60 days. The Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check.
- A 4% convenience fee will be charged for credit card transactions.
- 6. If a horse becomes injured or ill prior to being shown in any class, entry fees will be refunded upon receipt of a Veterinarian's certificate. An office-processing fee of \$25 per legitimately excused animal will be deducted from the refund. All certificates, to be considered, must be received by show management before the closing of the show. No credit will be given for classes scratched after it has started.
- 7. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Main Show Ring 300' x 200'. Main Warm Up Ring: 220 x 200'. Ring 2: 275' x 160'. Ring 3: 240' x 160' sand footing. Ring 2 and 3 Warm Up: 200' x 160'. Footing in ring 1, 2 and warm ups is the highest International Standard. Full drainage with the very best sand and GGT geotextile throughout.
- Riders must be properly attired for all classes. Jackets are required in all classes unless waived due to inclement weather.
 Protective headgear is required at all times when mounted on the show grounds. It must meet or exceed ASTM standards for equestrian use, carry the SEI tag, and be properly fitted with harness secured. Formal attire (white breeches and riding jacket) for Classics.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS and measurement cards for any and all classes, which require the same.
- ENTRIES CLOSE by the date marked on the entry blanks. No entry will be considered valid unless accompanied by full payment.

- 12. The right is reserved to limit the number of entries accepted in any and all divisions. If entries must be limited, they will be selected on a first come, first served basis, selected by postmark date. POST ENTRIES Accepted on a space available basis.
- 13. Numbers will not be issued until a signed, open check is lodged with the horse show secretary and all USEF membership cards have been seen & verified.
- 14. Horses shown in a class without being entered will pay double the class entry fee.
- 15. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- \$50 charge for non-competing horses brought into any show ring for hacking and/or schooling. Back numbers must be worn in Show Rings to verify entry.
- 17. There will be a \$25 grounds fee.
- 18. A fee of \$250 will be charged to exhibitor's account for any returned check.
- Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
- 20. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 21. Breaking ties for other than first place will be done by time taken in the first round.
- 22. Classes with prize money need 10 to fill.
- 23. Riders must be present, as requested, for all presentations, to be eligible for awards.
- 24. Sharps containers will be available in the stabling area.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions.

8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
