*Penn St and Illinois played in the first 9 OT game in CFB history last Saturday. The Fighting Illini pulled off the shocking upset 20-18 as 24.5-point underdogs. Illinois was +1225 on the money-line. The two teams combined to miss 10 straight 2-point conversion attempts in OT!*

Rice was +30 ATS points vs UAB in a 30-24 upset win (+24).  
The Wake Forest/Army game went OVER the total by 72.5 points!  
The Memphis/UCF game went UNDER the total by 32 points  
UTSA is 7-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 10.2 ppg!  
Syracuse is 7-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 8.1 ppg!  
Missouri has failed to cover the spread in 10 straight games by an average of 11.4 ppg.  
Clemson has failed to cover the spread in 8 straight games by an average of 13.3 ppg.  
The OVER is 6-1 in Tulane games going OVER by an average of 9.7 ppg!  
The UNDER is 7-1 in Illinois games going UNDER by an average of 10.4 ppg!

#### Misleading Finals

**Kent St beat Ohio 34-27.** However, the yards were even at 457-457 but Kent St was +3 in TO's.

**Houston beat East Carolina 31-24 in OT.** However, ECU had a 360-256 yard edge but were -2 in TO's.

**Liberty beat North Texas 35-26.** However, North Texas had 29-21 first down and 454-350 yard edges including 242-45 on the ground. North Texas was -2 in TO's and blew a 26-14 lead in the 3Q. North Texas was intercepted at the Liberty 1-yard line, stopped on downs at the Liberty 7, allowed a 72-yard punt return TD and missed a 26-yard FG.

**UTSA beat Louisiana Tech 45-16.** However, LT had 24-21 first down and 408-406 yard edges but were done in by a -3 TO margin including a long "Pick 6".

**San Diego St beat Air Force 20-14.** However, AF had a 259-229 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. San Diego St got 2 FG "drives" on a total of 16 yards of offense after AF's two TO's.

**Hawaii beat New Mexico St 48-34.** However, NM St had a 485-482 yard edge. Hawaii got two long "Pick 6's". A 79-yarder in the 2Q and a 75-yarder in the 4Q.

#### Bad Beats

**Arkansas was a 51-point favorite** vs FCS Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Arkansas led 45-0 at halftime and didn't score in the second half, "only" winning 45-3.

**Tennessee (+25) only trailed Alabama 31-24 in the fourth quarter** but allowed the Crimson Tide to score the game's final 21 points. The last 5 minutes were the only time all game, the Tide were covering.

**Nevada (+3.5) got a 12-yard TD pass** with :02 left to get the back-door vs Fresno St. The Wolf Pack's 2-point conversion was no good and they "only" lost 34-32. **The total in the game was 64** and that last TD also put the game OVER by 2 points.

**The total in the Buffalo/Akron game was 58.** It was 45-10 Buffalo in the middle of the 3Q. Akron appeared to score a TD late in the 3Q but it was ruled out of bounds at the 1-yard line (controversial call). Akron, 2 plays later, would then fumble it out of the end zone for a touch back. The two teams would combine to have 3 more drives inside the opponent's 40-yard line but there was no more scoring.

#### Injuries/Personnel News

Georgia QB JT Daniels (back) is questionable vs Florida.  
Hawaii QB Chevan Cordeiro (shoulder) is questionable vs Utah St.  
Illinois QB Artur Sitkowski (arm) is out for the season.  
Indiana's top 2 QB's Michael Penix (shoulder) and Jack Tuttle (lower body) are doubtful for this week's game vs Maryland. True freshman Donaven McCulley is likely to make his first career start.  
Liberty QB Malik Willis (foot) is probable vs Massachusetts.  
Miami, FL S Bubba Bolden (shoulder) is out for the season. Bolden was Miami's leading tackler so far this season.  
Notre Dame All-American S Kyle Hamilton (knee) is out vs North Carolina.  
South Carolina QB Zeb Noland (knee) is probable vs Florida.  
Tulane QB Michael Pratt (head) is questionable vs Cincinnati.  
UCLA QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson (shoulder) is questionable vs Utah.  
Vanderbilt QB Ken Seals (finger) is questionable vs Missouri.

Texas Tech football coach Matt Wells has been fired after two-plus seasons in charge. Despite the Red Raiders being 5-3 this season, Athletic director Kirby Hocutt said Saturday's loss to Kansas State, in which Tech blew a 14-point second-half lead, made it clear there was no point in waiting. Tech will likely be an underdog in all four remaining games: at No. 4 Oklahoma, home against No. 22 Iowa State and No. 15 Oklahoma State and the finale at No. 16 Baylor. Offensive Coordinator Sonny Cumbie, who played quarterback at Texas Tech for Mike Leach between 2000 and 2004, will serve as the interim head coach. Wells' .433 winning percentage was the second worst in school history to Jerry Moore (.309 from 1981 to '85) among coaches who spent more than one season in Lubbock.

#### Recapping Week 8 Best Bets

Our College best bets went 3-2 with both of our top plays winning. Colorado and Boston College disappointed us as their offenses didn't show up. We did win the UNDER in the Michigan/Northwestern game. The NFL went 1-2. The total in the Indianapolis/San Francisco game dropped several points due to weather but we still couldn't get to the window. New England was an easy winner and our teaser loss as the Ravens were crushed. So far we are a combined 35-28-2 56% on the year.

### Games in Rotation Order Thursday, October 28th

**COASTAL CAROLINA 38 Troy 20.** Troy comes in off a bye but despite their 4-3 straight up record, they have failed to cover 4 straight games. Their defense is legit allowing just 287 ypg (No. 7) and notching 31 sacks already. Meanwhile, Coastal comes in off their first regular season loss in 2 years. It will be interesting to see if there is any "Bubble Burst" in effect for them. We did bet Coastal -16 and OVER on the openers but check that weather forecast with wind and rain bringing the total down a bit. We're passing for now.

**EAST CAROLINA 33 South Florida 24.** USF comes in off their first win over an FBS opponent in 2 years as they dominated Temple last week. However, the Bulls are still No. 123 in yards per play margin (-1.9) for the season. Meanwhile, ECU comes in off an OT loss at Houston. The Pirates had a big yardage edge and it was their 3rd straight cover. However, that's 3 close losses for them and they need this game if they have any hope for bowl eligibility. ECU is No. 86 in ypp margin (-0.09). We bet ECU -6 on the Sunday open but would lean with USF now at the 10-point spread.

### Friday, October 29th

**TULSA 30 Navy 20.** Tulsa comes in off a bye with extra time to prep for the option. The Golden Hurricane have won back-to-back games as need another here to stay in bowl contention. They are a respectable No. 58 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, Navy had one of their best performances of the season in a close loss vs No. 2 Cincinnati. They have now covered 4 of their last 5 games but still rank No. 124 in ypp margin (-2.01). We don't see much value on the side but do lean OVER which is 6-1 in Tulsa games this year.

**NEVADA 38 UNLV 18.** The Battle for the Fremont Cannon. UNLV is one of two remaining winless teams in the FBS (Arizona the other). In fact, the Rebels still haven't won a game under head coach Marcus Arroyo in two years (0-13). The last win for the Rebels was former head coach Tony Sanchez' last game over this Nevada team in 2019. The Wolf Pack lost a heart-breaker last week at Fresno St as they lost control of the West Division. UNLV has lost 5 games by 8 points or less with only Arizona St and Iowa St getting margin over them. We bet UNDER 62.5 on the openers but only lean that way now.

### Saturday, October 30th

**WISCONSIN 20 Iowa 19.** Iowa comes in off a bye after suffering their first loss of the season vs Purdue. The Hawkeyes had been living off turnovers all year but were -3 in that game. Still, they are +12 in TO margin on the season. Meanwhile, Wisconsin is -8 in TO margin this year which played a big part in their 3 losses. The Badgers are playing better as of late as they have won 3 straight and are No. 20 in the country in ypp margin (+1.27) while Iowa is No. 72 (+0.26). We lean with Iowa here but make sure you shop for that "+3.5". This is the lowest total in CFB so far this season (involving FBS teams).

**BUFFALO 33 Bowling Green 21.** After we lost fading them on these pages two weeks ago, Bowling Green was predictably crushed by Eastern Michigan last week. Their youth and lack of depth might be starting to show now that they are playing their 9th straight week. Meanwhile, Buffalo crushed Akron last week (same Zips team who beat BG). It is note-worthy that despite playing similar schedules BG is No. 90 in ypp margin while Buffalo is No. 97. We have a slight lean on the OVER.

**WAKE FOREST 40 Duke 26.** Duke comes in off a bye after by far their worst performance of the season, a 48-0 loss to Virginia. If they're going to show any fight down the stretch, we'll find out here. They're taking on an unbeaten Wake team that won for us on these pages last week in that exciting shootout at Army. However, we like Duke here as the Blue Devils offense that averages 473 ypg (No. 13) should have success vs that Wake defense.

**Michigan 27 MICHIGAN ST 23.** One of the biggest games in the history of this storied series. Michigan St is on a 11-2 ATS run in the series including a 27-24 outright win as 21.5-point underdogs last year. Both teams have been super impressive not only on the scoreboard but also in the box score. Michigan St is No. 6 in yards per play margin (+2.1) while Michigan is No. 16 (+1.49). The team that wins the line of scrimmage usually wins this game as the team with the most rushing yards is on a 45-6 run in the rivalry. MSU out-rushed their opponents on average 201-120 while Michigan is out-rushing their opponents by an average of 253-116. We like Michigan to win but don't see too much value at the current numbers (We bet UNDER 53.5 on Sunday).

**NC STATE 30 Louisville 24.** NC State suffered their first conference loss last week in a 31-30 upset at Miami. Meanwhile, Louisville beat us on these pages with their win and cover over Boston College. Neither team can afford another loss if they want to keep pace in the Atlantic Division with Wake Forest. We bet UNDER 60.5 on the open and still lean that way.

**SYRACUSE 28 Boston College 24.** Boston College let us down on these pages last week in their 28-14 loss at Louisville. That's now 3 straight losses for them and they need to get their season back on track. Meanwhile, Syracuse is a nation-best 7-1 ATS and the Orange have covered in 6 straight games! After

3 straight last-second losses (straight up), they got a thrilling upset win at Virginia Tech last week to give them a shot at bowl eligibility down the stretch. However, now you're starting to see some premiums on their point spreads and this is only their 2nd favorite role of the season. We lean with BC.

**Georgia St 31 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 24.** We bet Georgia St -3 on the Sunday openers. The Panthers have won back-to-back games and need this one to remain in bowl contention. They're taking on a Georgia Southern team that looked lost in their last game, a blowout at South Alabama. They are finishing the season with an interim coach and Georgia Southern is only No. 121 in ypp margin this year (-1.87). However, with a 3.5-point line move, we're only leaning Georgia St now.

**Iowa St 28 WEST VIRGINIA 21.** The unranked Iowa St Cyclones took down the No. 8 Oklahoma State Cowboys. Huge upset right? Nope. It's just so sad to see in this day and age of gambling legalization that the National Media and fans failed to realize Iowa St was a TD favorite in the game and actually under-achieved in the 24-21 win. Iowa St may have two losses but statistically they are a Top 10 team at +167 ypg (No. 6) and +1.99 in ypp (No. 8). Who knows what West Virginia team is going to show up this week. You're guess is as good as ours. Last week off the bye, they upset TCU. That's after two dreadful performances vs Texas Tech and Baylor. We're passing.

**MARYLAND 30 Indiana 24.** Both teams are reeling. Maryland has lost 3 straight by an average of 35 ppg. Still, the Terps are No. 64 in ypp margin (+0.42). Indiana has played the toughest schedule in the country so far. However, they are also 0-6 ATS vs FBS teams failing to cover by 13.5 ppg. The Hoosiers are No. 112 in ypp margin and will be down to a 3rd string true freshman QB here with Michael Penix and Jack Tuttle both out. All the early week money has been on Maryland and that includes us.

**FLORIDA ATLANTIC 30 Utep 17.** UTEP comes in off a bye after that beat down of Louisiana Tech that shocked us a couple weeks ago. The Miners have played an easy schedule but they are still No. 26 in ypp margin (+1.18) and No. 31 in ypg margin (+92.1). They are bowl eligible already and remember their season win total was only 3! Meanwhile, FAU is off a dominant win over Charlotte last week and have played a tougher schedule than UTEP. We bet UNDER 53.5 on the openers. Both teams defenses allow 21 ppg or less. Slight lean FAU at the current number with all the money on UTEP driving this number down.

**PITTSBURGH 35 Miami, FL 26.** If we consider the point spread to be a measure of expectation, no team has done better exceeding expectations than Pitt this year with a 6-1 ATS mark by an average of 11.9 ppg. They control their own destiny in the ACC after their big win over Clemson last week. The Panthers are up to No. 11 in our power ratings and statistically it is deserved. Pitt is No. 4 in ypp margin (+202.3), No. 5 in scoring margin (+25.7) and No. 13 in ypp margin (+1.66). They're taking on a Miami team off their best performance of the season, an upset win over NC State. The Hurricanes haven't quit on the season, but they are really banged up with a half dozen starters out for the year including their leading tackler Bubba Bolden who was declared out this week. Both side and total are right near our numbers. Pass. Note the Westgate opened this line Miami -3 in the summer.

**3★ Rutgers 24 Illinois 20.** These two teams are pretty even stats wise (Rutgers No. 111 in ypp margin, Illinois No. 113). However, this is our situational play of the week. You have a Rutgers team fresh off a bye taking on an Illinois team fresh off the first 9 overtime game in college football history. On top of that, it was one of the biggest upsets in Illinois football history winning outright as 24.5-point underdogs over Penn St. Finally, they lost their QB Artur Sitkowski (6-2 TD-to-INT ratio) for the season to injury. Sitkowski has been surprisingly better than Brandon Peters (1-1 ratio) this season.

**Minnesota 26 NORTHWESTERN 19.** The first couple of things you think of with Minnesota this season are probably their shocking upset loss as 30-point favorites to Bowling Green and their injuries at the RB position. The reality is this team has overcome both of those negatives and has won and covered 3 straight Big Ten games. Meanwhile, this is a rebuilding year for Northwestern and last week they were outscored 23-0 to close the game at Michigan as they couldn't cover as huge underdogs. With that said, we're not sure we want to lay more than a TD here. Slight lean OVER.

**Central Florida 34 TEMPLE 23.** Temple is off by far their worst performance of the season. After a bye, they were crushed by USF as they were out-FD'd 34-8 and out-rushed 421-48! That's a type of performance that makes you wonder about the program moving forward. Meanwhile, UCF played a Memphis team with a 3rd string QB last week and took advantage in a 24-7 win. We bet OVER on Sunday but make sure you're checking that weather forecast first.

**GEORGIA TECH 30 Virginia Tech 26.** Last week was most likely the beginning of the end for Virginia Tech head coach Justin Fuente blowing a 9-point lead in the final minutes vs Syracuse. The Hokies have now failed to cover in 5 straight games and stand at just 3-4 on the season despite playing 6 of their first 7 games at home! They're taking on a Georgia Tech team that lost a shoot-out vs Virginia last week although it should be noted the Yellow Jackets scored a couple of late TD's to make the final more respectable. Georgia Tech is No. 63 in ypp margin, Virginia Tech is No. 99. All the early week money is on GT but after betting GT -2, we're not running to the window to lay 4.

**CLEMSON 30 Florida St 17.** The Tigers are now on a 0-8 ATS run dating back to last year failing to cover by 13.25 ppg. We've downgraded them by far more than any team in the country and we're still higher on them than the market (see page 6 and 7). Meanwhile, the Noles have won 3 straight and are up to No. 37 in ypp margin. Our numbers say Clemson but our head says FSU. Note the summer line on this game was Clemson -27!

**LIBERTY 45 Massachusetts 10.** Yes, we know UMass beat Connecticut earlier this season but why are the Minutemen dead last in our power ratings? How about dead last in ypg margin (-210.5), dead last in scoring margin (-29.3) and dead last in ypp margin (-2.78). Still, we bet UMass +38 in this game on the Sunday openers because we bet numbers, not teams. Right now, something is wrong with Liberty. After losing outright as 32-point favorites to ULM, they probably should have lost outright as 21-point favorites vs North Texas last week. It was the most misleading final of the week (see page 1). We're not sure that QB Willis is 100% as he was in and out of the line-up in last week's game. We also lean UNDER.

**RICE 29 North Texas 27.** Heading into last week Rice was dead last in the country in ATS margin at -18 ppg. We bet their opponent UAB -20 on the Sunday opener. The line closed -24. So what does Rice do? How about win the game outright as 24-point underdogs! Meanwhile, North Texas almost pulled off a shocker themselves as they blew a 26-14 3Q lead vs Liberty (see page 1). We haven't bet side or total in this one. Pass.

**UTAH ST 35 Hawaii 28.** Hawaii comes off a misleading win over New Mexico St. That's their 2nd one in the last 3 games. Hawaii freshman QB Brayden Schager, could be making his 4th consecutive start in place of injured Chevan Cordeiro (shoulder) here. Meanwhile, Utah St held on for dear life vs Colorado St last week (much to the dismay of our VIP clients). We lean with Utah St here but note the Aggies are No. 103 in ypp margin while Hawaii is No. 68.

**BYU 31 Virginia 30.** Virginia coach Bronco Mendenhall returns to BYU where he was the head coach from 2005-2015 going to 11 straight bowl games. The Cavs have won and covered 4 straight games and are led by the nation's leading passer Brennan Armstrong who has 3,220 yards and a 23-6 ratio. Meanwhile, BYU got a bounce-back win but failed to cover for the 3rd straight game as they stopped a 2-point conversion by Washington St to hold on 21-19 (-3.5). UVA is No. 25 in ypp margin and No. 32 in scoring margin. Slight lean on them in what should be one of the most competitive games of the weekend. We also lean UNDER.

**UTAH 31 UCLA 26.** The major question in this game will be the health status of UCLA QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson who was hurt late in the Bruins' loss to Oregon last week. Currently, this line of Utah -6.5 says DTR is more doubtful than questionable. If he doesn't go, Ethan Garbers will get the start (threw the game-ending INT last week). Meanwhile, just when you thought the Utes were turning their season around, they lose outright at Oregon St last week. We didn't bet this game yet as much of it relies on how fast you can get to the DTR injury news.

**ARIZONA ST 33 Washington St 18.** Arizona St comes in off a bye. With Utah's loss last week, the Sun Devils have new life in the Pac-12 South race. Note ASU is a very impressive No. 9 in the country in ypp margin (+1.95). That's one of the main reasons why they're laying more than 2 TD's here. The other is the uncertainty of the coaching staff at Washington St. Sure, the Cougars gave great effort last week in their 21-19 loss to BYU (+3.5) but losing a head coach and 4 assistants will hurt more as time passes. It is noteworthy that the Cougs have covered 5 straight games. We lean UNDER.

**CALIFORNIA 27 Oregon St 26.** Oregon St has been one of the "sharps" darlings this year and rightly so as the Beavers are now one win away from bowl eligibility after upsetting Utah last week. They're taking on a Cal team that crushed us on these pages last week in their decisive 26-3 win over Colorado. That's two straight really good performances out of them. We lean with Cal and did bet UNDER 58.5 on the Sunday opener.

**USC 37 Arizona 17.** After watching USC play hard (but undisciplined) in the loss to Notre Dame last week, we'd thought they would be in store for a let-down this week after playing their rival. The problem in wanting to fade them is that their opponent Arizona comes in on a 19-game losing streak and clearly has a "here we go again, the sky is falling" mentality. It was on full display late Friday night. The Wildcats were up 16-7 in the fourth quarter vs a highly over-rated Washington team. Arizona was driving to likely put the game away but one turnover completely changed the game and it was like watching air come out of a balloon on the sidelines. We lean UNDER here.

**SAN JOSE ST 22 Wyoming 19.** Wyoming's season is on the brink after losing outright as 20-point favorites last week. The Cowboys have scored just 3 combined points in their last 2 games and have now failed to cover in 4 straight. They're taking on a San Jose St team that got a much-needed win over UNLV last week. The Spartans are slightly better in ypp margin (No. 55 vs No. 67) and we bet them -1 on the Sunday openers. At -3 though, we're passing.

**OREGON 34 Colorado 13.** Colorado really disappointed us on these pages last week in their 26-3 loss to California. The Buffs offense now ranks dead last averaging just 238 ypg. Meanwhile, Oregon "Rose" up and beat UCLA as short-underdogs last week. Oregon is the much better team ranking No. 24 in ypp margin while Colorado is No. 117. However, Oregon has played to the level of their competition this year. The underdog in Oregon games is 7-0 ATS with an average cover of 9.6 ppg. We bet Colorado +28 and UNDER 51.5 on the Sunday openers and still lean that way.

**MARSHALL 41 Florida International 21.** Marshall comes in off a bye. Statistically the Thundering Herd have been impressive this year ranking No. 11 in ypp margin (+1.78). They're also No. 18 in ypp margin (+117.5) and No. 21 in scoring margin (+14.3). The problem is they've lost two games outright as a double-digit favorite. Meanwhile, at just 1-6 this looks like the final season for Butch Davis at FIU. Still, the Golden Panthers are (+0.03) in ypp and their offense is capable of getting a back-door here.

**OKLAHOMA ST 44 Kansas 13.** Oklahoma St comes in off their first loss of the season. Despite being the No. 8 team and their opponent Iowa St being unranked, the Cowboys actually covered the spread as 7-point underdogs. They're taking on a Kansas team that at one-point early in the 4Q led Oklahoma and were on the verge of pulling one of the biggest upsets in the history of CFB. The Jayhawks ended up losing but still it was one of their better performances in recent memory. Is that effort repeatable here or is it back to the reality where they didn't cover a point spread in their first 6 games? Slight lean OVER. Also note the Pokes have covered in 5 straight games.

**2★ OVER 52 Louisiana Tech 33 OLD DOMINION 24.** The Bulldogs have had a tough-luck season so far. They've blown a 20-point lead vs Mississippi St, lost on a "Hail Mary" to a good SMU team, had a yardage at NC State in a 7-point loss and last week had a misleading blowout loss to UTSA (see page 1). ODU is also having a tough luck season with 3 close losses. We just think LT has much higher upside. We also like OVER here as both teams are above average in terms of tempo. LT is No. 48 in plays per minute while ODU is No. 22. Yet, we have a below average totals line here. Early weather forecast is good.

**UL-LAFAYETTE 39 Texas St 18.** ULL hasn't really impressed us this season. Sure, they're winning as they have gone 6-0 since losing to Texas in the opener. But they are just 2-5 ATS on the season and the blowout win over Appalachian St looks more like the outlier. Especially after they only beat Arkansas St by 1 last week. They're taking on a Texas St team that is No. 114 in ypp margin this year. The early week money is on ULL in this game but we're sitting this one out.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE 31 Southern Miss 17.** Southern Miss comes in off a much-needed bye. The Golden Eagles are down to a 3rd-string QB and are No. 120 in ypp margin (-1.84). They are 0-6 ATS vs FBS teams this year failing to cover by 10 ppg. They're facing a Middle Tennessee team that probably smells some blood in the water especially after the Blue Raiders dispatched another bottom-dweller in UConn last week 44-13. Still, this side and total is close to our numbers. Pass.

**NEBRASKA 28 Purdue 21.** Nebraska comes in off a bye and we are now in "must-win" territory for head coach Scott Frost. The Huskers are 0-5 in games decided by 8-points or less this season and are a nation-worst 5-17 in close games since he took over in 2018. Is that bad coaching, bad luck or having a turnover prone QB? The answer is all 3 in our opinion. Statistically the Huskers are very good boasting a No. 15 rank in ypp margin and No. 13 in ypg margin. They're taking on a Purdue team that's just played back-to-back physical games vs Iowa and Wisconsin. Totals' players note the UNDER is 6-1 in Purdue games going UNDER by an average of 14 ppg. That's where our money is.

**MISSOURI 37 VANDERBILT 23.** Missouri comes in off a bye. The Tigers have remarkably failed to cover the spread in 10 straight games dating back to last season by an average of 11.35 ppg. The main culprit this year is a defense that ranks No. 126 in total D allowing 489 ypg. With that being said, Vandy's offense ranks No. 124 averaging just 291 ypg. So it's the "movable object vs the resistible force" in this one. Vandy is No. 128 in ypp margin at (-2.23) while Missouri's offense is by far the best unit on the field. Still, we lean with Vandy here as Missouri moves to 0-11 ATS.

**KANSAS ST 30 TCU 27.** TCU head coach Gary Patterson will likely end up in the Hall of Fame after his career is over. However, this TCU program is slipping as he is in his 21st season in Fort Worth. The Horned Frogs have covered just one game this year. With games against Baylor, Oklahoma St and Iowa St still left, they're likely heading towards a 2nd losing season in 3 years. Meanwhile, Kansas St might have turned their season around in a come-from-behind win over Texas Tech last week. That snapped a 8-game Big 12 losing streak for them. Our numbers lean TCU but we didn't bet side or total.

**KENTUCKY 26 MISSISSIPPI ST 25.** Kentucky comes in off a bye. The Wildcats 6-0 ATS vs FBS teams this year with an average cover of 7.5 ppg. They've looked the part in the box score too with a No. 35 ypp margin (+1.35). Meanwhile, Mississippi St comes in off a blowout win over Vanderbilt. Despite relying on just a pass attack, the Bulldogs are -0.1 in ypp (No. 87). Our numbers say Mississippi St is the play but we prefer the OVER.

**OKLAHOMA 42 Texas Tech 22.** Oklahoma freshman QB Caleb Williams has made several "Heisman-esque" plays in just a few games. However, you shouldn't need to make that kind of play(s) to beat Kansas! The reality is this 8-0 Oklahoma team has too many flaws to be considered a legit National Title contender at this point. Yes, they're No. 4 in our power ratings but No. 3 Ohio St would be favored by more than a TD over them and both Georgia and Alabama would be favored by double-digits. On the other side, Texas Tech fired head coach Matt Wells after the Red Raiders blew the game vs Kansas St last week. Sonny Cumbie who played QB at Tech is the interim. Statistically these teams are close as TT is No. 34 in ypp margin (+1.1) while Oklahoma is No. 33 (+1.12). However, we're passing.

**OHIO ST 39 Penn St 20.** Penn St comes in off the historical 9 overtime loss to Illinois as 24.5-point favorites. Incredibly the two teams missed 10 straight 2-point conversion attempts in a row. If we assume a 48% conversion rate on 2-point attempts (NFL stat), the chances of going 0 for 10 are 0.06% or around 1 in 1,667 chance! Nittany Lion QB Sean Clifford didn't look 100% after returning from injury and the Penn St defense was run over. Now they're facing a red-hot Ohio St team that has won and covered 4 in a row. During their win streak the offense is averaging 58 ppg and QB CJ Stroud has a 14-0 TD-to-INT ratio in the last 3 games alone. Ohio St is No. 1 in the country in ypp margin (+3.57). The early money has been on Ohio St and we're part of it as we bet the Buckeyes -16.5.



**2★ Smu 32 HOUSTON 29.** A really good Group of 5 match-up here and the winner has the inside track to the AAC Championship likely against Cincinnati. SMU is 7-0 and outscoring opponents by 20 ppg (No. 9). Houston has won 6 straight games after dropping the opener to Texas Tech and are +19 ppg (No. 11) in scoring margin. SMU is No. 39 in ypp margin while Houston is No. 48. We think SMU's Sonny Dykes is the better coach than his counterpart Dana Holgorsen. Another advantage is SMU played last Thursday while Houston endured a 5-hour lightning delay in a fortunate OT win over East Carolina.

**Texas 31 BAYLOR 30.** Don't look now but Baylor is 6-1 and their stats say they are a Top 10 caliber team as they are No. 5 in ypp margin (+2.24) and No. 10 in scoring margin (+19.6). The problem is they've taken on a relatively light schedule (No. 75 in Sagarin's SOS) and when they've had to step up in competition, they were out-gained by nearly 200 yards in a fortunate win over Iowa St and lost by 10 to Oklahoma St. Yes, Texas is just 4-3 but the Horns have played a much tougher schedule. Our numbers like Texas here.

**3★ AUBURN 34 Ole Miss 29.** Really nice spot for Auburn here catching Ole Miss off 4 straight big and emotional games vs Alabama (Kiffin vs Saban), Arkansas (52-51 thriller) Tennessee (Kiffin's return to Knoxville) and LSU (Manning celebration day). Meanwhile, the Tigers are off a bye. Statistically, Auburn has been the better team as the Tigers are No. 14 in ypp margin (Ole Miss No. 22) and No. 15 in scoring margin (Ole Miss No. 22). Auburn lost a close game at night at Penn St and also to No. 1 Georgia. They've been pretty consistent. We like them here especially at -2.5.

† **Georgia 31 Florida 17.** @TIAA Bank Field in Jacksonville, FL. Georgia is a 14-point favorite vs Florida this week. If that line holds, it will be Georgia's largest favorite role ever in the "World's Largest Outdoor Cocktail Party" series. Both teams come in off a bye. The Bulldogs are No. 1 in ypp margin (+221.3), No. 1 in scoring margin (+31.8) and No. 3 in ypp margin (+3.15). Florida is No. 7 in ypg (+163.3) and No. 7 in ypp margin (+2.0) but a -7 TO margin has them sitting at 3 losses on the season already. There's QB questions for both teams as will JT Daniels finally return for Georgia? Will Anthony Richardson start over Emory Jones for Florida? Our numbers are close to the spread here and we didn't bet it. Remember, just because it's one of the biggest games of the week, doesn't mean it offers up the best value.

**Cincinnati 44 TULANE 20.** Cincinnati had a close call vs Navy last week. Obviously, the Bearcats have a "Bullseye" on their backs and it will be interesting to see how they respond after their first non-cover vs a FBS team this season. They are still No. 4 in ypp margin and No. 4 in scoring margin and they need style points. Cincy is taking on a reeling Tulane team that is 0-5 SU/ATS in their last 5 games and their QB Michael Pratt was banged up last week. Early week money is on Cincinnati but we haven't bet the side or total. Pass.

**APPALACHIAN ST 42 UL-Monroe 14.** What a job Terry Bowden has done at ULM in his first year. ULM was 0-10 last year. This year they've already won 4 games and have pulled shocking outright upsets as 23.5-point underdogs to Troy, 32.5-point dogs to Liberty and last week as 13.5-point dogs to South Alabama. Statistically, they had their best game last week as they rolled up 555 yards of offense. On the other side, App St is off their best performance of the season, an upset over unbeaten Coastal Carolina. Now the Mountaineers are in the driver's seat of the East Division. Taking ULM at this point as a 4-TD underdog seems too easy. We bet UNDER 61 on the openers.

**SOUTH ALABAMA 35 Arkansas St 29.** Arkansas St's stats are terrible as the Red Wolves are No. 129 in ypp margin (-2.4). They have the worst defense in the country allowing 578.6 ypg and an incredible 8.28 yards per play. Still, our numbers really like them in this match-up and they did only lose to league power Louisiana by 1 last week. Meanwhile, South Alabama's stats are pretty respectable (No. 57 in ypp margin) but the Jags have played a very weak schedule. We bet Arkansas St +11 on Sunday and still lean with them.

**WESTERN KENTUCKY 43 Charlotte 27.** Big stat disparity here as WKU is No. 19 in ypp margin (+1.42) while Charlotte is No. 115 (-1.18). Charlotte was over-matched in the second half vs FAU last week. Meanwhile, WKU is thinking East division title with huge games vs FAU and Marshall to close the season. Just like last week though we think WKU is a little pricey as they failed to cover as 16.5-point favorites vs FIU and this Charlotte team is better than FIU. We did bet UNDER 77 on Sunday. Yes, WKU OVERs have been profitable but that totals' line was by far their highest of the season.

**Boise St 27 COLORADO ST 24.** Boise St comes in off a much-needed bye. The Broncos are -0.62 in ypp margin (No. 102) and No. 99 in ypg margin (-43.3 ypg). Meanwhile, Colorado St is No. 49 in ypp margin (+0.74) and No. 19 in ypp margin (+114.6). So why is Boise St a road favorite? It's because they've played the much tougher schedule. Also, it will be interesting to see how Colorado St's players respond after head coach Steve Addazio threw them under the bus in the ridiculous finish at Utah St last week. Clock management is on you coach! We bet UNDER 55.5 on the Sunday open.

**2★ North Carolina 31 NOTRE DAME 30.** North Carolina comes in off a bye while Notre Dame just played their rival USC. The Tar Heels are the better team statistically as they are No. 25 in ypp margin (+1.18) and No. 30 in ypp margin (+93) while Notre Dame is No. 83 in ypp (-0.06) and No. 83 in ypg (-0.39). ND has played the tougher schedule. There is a key injury that is not getting properly priced in the market place. ND All-America safety Kyle Hamilton is out and that's not good news vs this high-powered North Carolina offense. We like the Tar Heels here after the Hamilton news. Also note after not meeting expectation as a favorite all season, this is the first underdog role of the season for NC.

**STANFORD 26 Washington 23.** Washington has been one of the most disappointing teams in the country this year. The Huskies are 1-6 ATS and nearly lost to Arizona last week. Had that happened, we wonder if head coach Jimmy Lake would have survived even his second season. Meanwhile, Stanford comes in off the bye. Head coach David Shaw is a media darling but his clock management is arguably the worst in CFB game after game after game. Their was a reason Stanford's season win total was only 3.5. This program has slipped big time. We don't see much value here.

**Fresno St 24 SAN DIEGO ST 23.** The winner here has the inside track toward the West division title. Fresno has the better stats ranking No. 18 in ypp margin (+1.44) while San Diego St is No. 38 (+0.98). Obviously, the match-up to watch is Fresno St's No. 11 offense averaging 480 ypg vs San Diego St's No. 5 defense allowing just 279 ypg. Both teams come in off big wins as Fresno held on vs Nevada in the final seconds stopping a 2-point conversion (see bad beats on page 1) while San Diego St held on after leading Air Force 20-0. We did easily cash with them on these pages. Note Fresno RB Rivers has been upgraded to probable and we like the Bulldogs to end the Aztecs' unbeaten season.

**Tuesday, November 2nd**

**TOLEDO 31 Eastern Michigan 22.** Toledo has won 13 of the last 14 meetings and both teams are off their best performances of the season.

**Ball St 37 AKRON 18.** Ball St should get back on track after losing to Miami, Oh last week. The Zips are the worst team in the MAC.

**Miami, Oh 27 OHIO 22.** Ohio has been playing much better as of late while Miami routinely plays their best in conference play under coach Martin.

Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 5 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Texas +3**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

### Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, October 28th

**ARIZONA 28 Green Bay 22.** It doesn't get much better than this in the NFL regular season. 7-0 Arizona comes in with 5 straight ATS covers and a +15.8 ppg scoring margin. Meanwhile, 6-1 Green Bay comes in with 6 straight wins and covers. QB Aaron Rodgers has a 15-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in the Packers 6-game win streak. Green Bay was fortunate last week with Washington failing on 3 different red zone trips. If you're wondering why Arizona is nearly a full-TD favorite, the Packers were without their starting CB's last week and WR Adams might not play here as well. This is a "popcorn" game for us with nothing big on either side or total.

Sunday, October 31st

**BUFFALO 31 Miami 18.** Buffalo comes in off a bye after coming up short vs Tennessee on MNF. Meanwhile Miami is playing an 8th straight week and in their 4th different venue in as many weeks. They have lost 6 straight games since the opener allowing 32 ppg in that span. Tua did have 4 passing TD's last week in their near come-from-behind win over the Falcons. The Bills crushed the Dolphins 35-0 in Week 2 and have won 6 straight vs the Dolphins. They win comfortably again but we're not wild about laying doubles.

**ATLANTA 25 Carolina 21.** Two teams heading in opposite directions. The Falcons have won and covered 3 of their last 4 games. Their only loss in that stretch was blowing a 8-point lead with under 4 minutes left vs Washington. Matt Ryan has a 10-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio during that stretch. Meanwhile, the Panthers are on a 0-4 SU/ATS run. They managed just 3 points last week vs the lowly Giants. QB Sam Darnold was benched and the defense is allowing 29 ppg in the 4-game slide. Remember 2 of their 3 wins have come against the Texans and Jets. We lean with the Falcons here.

**Philadelphia 24 DETROIT 22.** The Eagles are off to their worst start since 1999. There was a ton of money that kept pouring in on Philadelphia last week. It proved to be wrong as they were easily handled by Las Vegas. Meanwhile, the Lions threw everything they had at the Rams last week but came up short. Detroit is playing really hard for Dan Campbell but the reality is this team is really short on talent and depth and the coaching isn't always optimal. Yes, they're covering some point-spreads but they still have 5 losses by 8 points or more. Money is once again coming in on Philly here but we're not laying more than a FG on the road with them.

**2★ INDIANAPOLIS 28 Tennessee 23.** Both teams are playing their best ball of the season. The Titans come in on a 5-1 SU/ATS run and won outright over the Bills and Chiefs as home dogs the last two weeks. Meanwhile, the Colts have covered 4 straight games with only the big blown lean at Baltimore being their only straight up loss in that span. Indy was really banged up when they lost 25-16 at Tennessee earlier this year. We think they get revenge here.

**L.A. Rams 31 HOUSTON 17.** The Texans looked good early vs Arizona but then allowed the game's final 31 points and couldn't cover one of the biggest point-spreads (+20) in NFL history. They have now been outscored 151-39 in their last 5 games with rookie QB Davis Mills starting (2-7 ratio). It won't get any better here vs the Rams who got a scare from the lowly Lions last week and should be more focused in this one. However, QB Tyrod Taylor could return here for Houston. That has us staying away for now.

**Cincinnati 28 N.Y. JETS 16.** The Bengals come in after one of their best performances in recent franchise history. A blowout win at Baltimore signifies that this team is going to be a real contender in the AFC this year. Meanwhile, the Jets are 1-5 SU/ATS and were absolutely crushed by the Pats last week as we cashed on these pages. Zach Wilson got hurt and as of press time it's not known who will start at QB for them (Mike White or Joe Flacco). The offense can't get much worse considering they haven't scored a point in the 1Q all season and are -86 total points in the first half so far. This is the Bengals 3rd straight road game and they are in a big division sandwich which downgrades them to only a lean here.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**CLEVELAND 24 Pittsburgh 19.** Early money has come in on Cleveland here. The Steelers are off a bye and have righted their season a bit with back-to-back wins. The question in this game is how healthy will Cleveland be here and does it really matter? They were able to win with Case Keenum last Thursday as they dominated the Broncos at the line of scrimmage. 3rd string RB D'Ernest Johnson (146 rush yards) proved very capable. We thought last year's playoff win in Pittsburgh by the Browns was a changing of the guard in this series.

**SAN FRANCISCO 21 Chicago 17.** Both teams need a win here to right the ship. Early money has come in on the 49ers. Last week Bears rookie QB Justin Fields had 5 TO's as they were destroyed by Tampa Bay. Meanwhile, San Francisco is on a 0-4 SU/ATS run and you have to wonder if head coach Shanahan deserves all the love he gets every year. He's had 1 winning season! We've lost two straight backing the 49ers but we think they're the "sharper" side here.

**SEATTLE 23 Jacksonville 19.** Jacksonville comes in off the bye while Seattle just lost on MNF. The Jags did end the 2nd longest losing streak (20 games) in NFL history prior to the bye getting 54 and 53-yard FG's late. Note Jacksonville rookie QB Lawrence threw 7 interceptions in his first 3 starts but has only thrown 1 in his last 3. Seattle is 2-0 ATS with Geno Smith at QB. However, the Seahawks were catching more than a FG in both games and now Seattle is laying points. Still, this number seems a bit cheap.

**2★ NE (plus the points) L.A. CHARGERS 27 New England 24.** The Chargers come in off the bye after getting destroyed by the Ravens in their last game. The Pats are 3-4 on the season but have to feel they could be 5-2 or better blowing close games vs Miami, Tampa Bay and Dallas all at home. We easily cashed with them last week in their blow-out win over the Jets. Remember, New England crushed the Chargers 45-0 in this building last year and Belichick feasts off young QB's and inexperienced head coaches. We'll take the points.

**DENVER 23 Washington 20.** Two teams that desperately need a win. Denver is on a 0-4 SU/ATS run since starting the season 3-0. QB Bridgewater is less than 100% and the defense was run over by a 3rd string RB last week in Cleveland. Meanwhile, Washington is a NFL-worst 1-6 ATS. The football team scored a grand total of 3 points in 4 red zone trips last week at Green Bay. We don't see much value.

**Tampa Bay 28 NEW ORLEANS 23.** The last time these two met, it was Tampa Bay winning at New Orleans in the playoffs. This just in... the defending Super Bowl champs are pretty good. They're fresh off a 38-3 beat down of the Bears last week. Tampa Bay is 6-1 for the first time in their history. Tom Brady just became the first QB ever to throw 600 TD passes and did it in a game where he had 4 TD's and ZERO INT's. The 28th time he's done that in his career. Obviously, the other story line is Jameis Winston getting his first start against his former team. We have the slightest of lean on New Orleans here but will wait and see if we get a better number on Sunday.

**3★ MINNESOTA 28 Dallas 27.** Dallas comes in the only 6-0 ATS team in the NFL and you know the betting public will want to play them here especially on a prime-time stand-alone game. The question we always ask when you're looking at backing a small road favorite is if this game were flipped to Dallas at home...would you want to lay Dallas -6 or -7 assuming 2 to 2.5-points of home field? We like Minnesota here. Kirk Cousins gets a lot of heat but in his last 16 games, he has a 37-to-5 TD-to-INT ratio. Minnesota is on a 16-5 ATS run as a home dog and we like them outright here.

Monday, November 1st

**KANSAS CITY 30 N.Y. Giants 20.** The Chiefs are now on a 3-14-1 ATS run dating back to last year. Quite simply, they are the most over-rated team in the NFL. The offense failed to score a TD for the first time with Mahomes under center last week and he took a big hit. How about 11 total turnovers and an interception in 6 straight games for Mahomes. Did that big contract get to his head? Meanwhile, the Giants are off their best performance of the season drilling the Panthers. A team off their worst vs a team off their best usually screams value in the NFL. We just don't want to lay doubles with KC. We lean UNDER.
