Juneau, Alaska

Today the ship arrives in Alaska's capital, Juneau. Free time to explore on your own or take advantage of the many exciting shore excursions available. Nestled between mountains and sea, Juneau has a rustic charm that's a blend of cosmopolitan and frontier styles. The Alaska State Museum includes a native clan house and a birch-bark canoe, gold rush memorabilia and Russian Orthodox relics. You can see nature up close on the Mt. Roberts alpine walk or on a whale-watching cruise. A short drive out of Juneau takes you to the impressive Mendenhall Glacier, one of 38 glaciers in the Juneau Icefield.

Skagway, Alaska

It's doubtful you'll succumb to gold fever, but if any place on earth can summon up the thrill of prospecting, it's Skagway. By embracing its gold-rush past, Skagway has managed to preserve a frontier spirit complete with saloons and dance-hall revues. If the spirit does overtake you, passage on the White Pass & Yukon Railway or a ride on the Klondike Highway will take you to places where you can roll up your sleeves and do some prospecting of your own.

Glacier Bay, Alaska - Cruising

Sail to Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve, a United Nations World Heritage Site. Comprised of 3.3 million acres of natural

wonders, it is home to magnificent glaciers, snow-capped mountains and abundant birds and wildlife.

Ketchikan, Alaska

In addition to being the jumping-off point for seaplane excursions into the Misty Fjords National Monument and its 2.2 million acres of wilderness nirvana, Ketchikan is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit tribe. Another "must-see" here is the world's largest collection of totem poles. Learn what motivates someone to turn a piece of lumber into a work of art at the Saxman Native Village, Totem Bight or Totem Heritage Center.

Alaska Inside Passage - Cruising

Threading along the scenic coast of Canada and Alaska, the Inside Passage offers spectacular close-up views of rain forests, sparkling glaciers, steep-walled fjords and snow-capped mountains. Watch closely for whale, sea lion. bear and other wildlife as the Inside Passage is home to more than 100 species of animals.

Victoria, British Columbia

The capital of British Columbia is also its largest island. This one-time British colony has retained much of its colonial splendor. Victoria is a seaside enclave that enjoys a temperate climate.
