

Bob and his wife are elderly and on a fixed income. Their house has a leak in the roof and a broken furnace. They can't afford to get the repairs done and wonder what will happen to them.

Mary's husband has become disabled and needs some handicap renovations in their home and a ramp at the door. Mary is dealing with her own health problems and the bills that come with that. Neither of them can work.

As tragic as these situations are, they are not solated cases. There is hope, however. Christmas in April St. Mary's County is a non-profit network of community based programs dedicated to the repair and rehabilitation of homes whose owners, due to unforeseen circumstances beyond their control, cannot complete even the most routine maintenance themselves.

What is Christmas in April?

Christmas in April St. Mary's County, Inc. is an all-volunteer program in which volunteers work together the LAST SATURDAY IN APRIL to repair the homes of low income, elderly and disabled homeowners.

Who is eligible?

Low income, elderly and/or disabled residents of St. Mary's County who own their home are eligible.

What types of repairs are done?

The work varies from house to house. Repairs may include plumbing, carpentry, electrical and general repairs, as well as yard clean up and trash removal. Non-working furnaces, hot water heaters and appliances may be replaced.

How are homes selected?

Individuals are referred to us through churches, synagogues, community service agencies, community organizations, as well as private individuals. Additionally, through local newspapers, radio stations and television we seek out applicants. A member of the House Selection Committee along with a representative from skilled labor make a site visit to determine the homeowner's eligibility and the feasibility of the repairs.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

Contribute cash:

We accept tax deductible contributions from individuals and organizations in any amount. You may wish to sponsor a house for a set donation.

Provide your expertise:

We need skilled tradespeople, such as electricians, plumbers, carpenters, roofers, landscapers and painters.

Donate materials and supplies:

Paint, paint accessories, fencing, doors, cleaning supplies, plumbing and electrical supplies, drywall, office supplies, etc. are always welcomed from dealers, manufacturers, and companies. Christmas in April St. Mary's County, Inc. also requires the assistance of support services such as printing, promotions, furnishings and food vendors.

Devote your time for one day:

No special skills are required. Anyone 14 years of age or older can volunteer.
