We love to reunite our kiddos with their personal belongings, but it is very hard if they are not labeled. Please help us keep the lost and found items to a minimum by marking your belongings. Information about School Absences

Health Related Absences

The health and well-being of each child attending our school is very important to us. Although we emphasize good attendance for all students, we recognize children do get sick. Keeping ill children at home helps prevent the spread of disease and is essential for our students with impaired immune- systems. Please talk to your student about positive prevention techniques such as hand washing, coughing into the elbow, and refraining from sharing food and drink. If your child has a major or chronic health concern, please call the school and ask to speak with our school nurse so that we may support your child's needs at school. Doctor's notes are always welcome to document a medical absence and safe return to school. The following district guidelines can be helpful when determining if a child is well enough to attend school:

Signs and Symptoms	Healthy & Ready to Attend School	
Fever: 100 degrees or higher	No fever for 24 hours and child feels well again.	
Runny nose with thick or colored secretions	No drainage for 24 hours and child feels well again	
Diarrhea / Vomiting	No diarrhea and /or vomiting for 24 hours. Child feels	
	well again and is able to eat.	
Persistent ear ache and / or drainage; significant	Seek medical advice to determine if medication is	
Sore throat and/or difficulty swallowing	needed. Child may return after 24 hours of prescribed	
	medication and feels well again.	
Redness of the eyes or eyelids, watery eyes,	Seek medical advice. Prescribed medication has been	
and/or discharge	started and symptoms relieved. Or, a written medical	
	release stating the child is not contagious.	
Unusual spots, rashes, or oozing areas not	Seek medical advice. A written medical release stating	
associated with injury	the child is not contagious is required.	

6th Graders 2020-21 School Year Pertussis (Whooping Cough) Immunization and Varicella Requirements

All 7th Grade Students will need to Provide Proof of a Pertussis Booster and 2nd Varicella vaccine.



On July 1, 2011, California Assembly Bill 354 requires that all 7th grade students entering school for the 2020-21 school year will be required to provide proof of a Tdap (Pertussis) booster. This may be met by receiving this booster on or after your child's 7th birthday.

In addition starting July 1 2019 all children will require a 2nd Varicella vaccine to enter

Safety for our Students, Parents and Staff!

Be Safe at Morning Drop Off and Afternoon Pick Up!

It is our intention and hope that all students and families arrive safe on campus. Please, please use caution and patience in the morning and afternoon. Please use the crosswalks at all times and avoid darting across Center Dr. and Lincoln Ave. Even drivers paying attention cannot see you or a young student suddenly running across the street. Please set a good example for your children, be courteous to other drivers and those using the crosswalk.

Morning Drop Off: 7:45 to 8:00 am

- Please DO NOT drop off early—especially in the back. Students are not supervised.
- Allow more time than you think you will need, traffic and parking do move slowly
- There is less traffic at 7:45am, so please plan and leave a few minutes earlier.
- Please check your parking spot, DO NOT park in stalls marked "STAFF"
- DO NOT park where curbs are painted red or with in 30 feet of a stop sign.

Dismissal 2:05 (K-3), 2:20 (4-6), Wednesdays all students dismissed at 12:15 pm

- Clarify your pickup location with your student(s)
- Post your name visibly in the front window for front lot drive up Older siblings should meet younger siblings
- Please be courteous and DO NOT cut in front of the drive up lane if there is cars already lined up waiting
- Please DO NOT ask your child to wait off campus
- Supervised Pick Up ends at 2:35
