COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Mental Health and Wellbeing

In light of COVID-19 which is affecting significant numbers of people across the world, the AIS Athlete Wellbeing team is providing some helpful information. This is a worldwide issue.

Common responses of people affected (both directly and indirectly) include:

- Fear of falling ill, losing livelihood, the challenges of securing the things you need (i.e. groceries and personal care items) being socially excluded or quarantined.
- Feeling of powerless in protecting loved ones or providing appropriate care and support.
- Feelings of hopelessness, boredom, loneliness and depression due to isolation.
- Uncertainty or ambivalence towards the situation, which may include high performance objectives as well as personal circumstances.
- Some people may find they experience positive emotions such as a sense of pride about finding ways of coping, a sense of resilience or satisfaction from witnessing community altruism and cooperation.

Ways to support yourself

- Limit media exposure to useful and quality information sources (e.g. the AIS website & Dept of Health website)
- Stay connected to your support network to foster a sense of normality, share feelings and relieve stress.
- Practice self-care by doing things that work for you and are consistent with health advisory guidelines e.g. additional physical activity, eat well, follow routine, meditate, do things you enjoy.
- Keep things in perspective by educating yourself about the facts and taking reasonable precautions as advised by reliable health information sources.

Ways to support others

- Share useful and quality information to friends and family.
- Be aware of the social stigma and discrimination that can be associated with pandemics and seek to be inclusive.
- Psychological First Aid is a research-informed method to help people (including ourselves) which looks at the

practical ways to support people by LOOKING out for people with serious distress reactions, LISTENING to needs and concerns and LINKING people with social support, information and professional help if needed.

Support and when to seek additional help

- While most people will be able to build on existing coping resources, we can expect that a minority of people will experience a negative response that worsens or does not settle over a period of weeks to months.
- A level of anxiety over coronavirus is completely normal however if the anxiety or stress you are experiencing continues to acutely impact on everyday life, and is not responding the strategies suggested above, a trained mental health professional may be able to help.

With this in mind, the AIS Mental Health Referral Network is opening its availability to impacted friends and family networks of our categorised athletes and staff in the high-performance sports that we service.

If people would like to seek mental health support or advice from the AIS Mental Health Referral Network, they or someone on their behalf can contact on the below details.

The service is covered Mon – Fri, 9am – 5pm AET. A qualified clinical psychologist is available to speak to them about their needs and connect them with one of our mental health professionals around Australia.

COVID-19 Update for Agistment, Riding & Coaches

From ESA:

The safety of our members and our community is paramount to Equestrian South Australia. Therefore, following our general update on Covid-19 issued earlier, we would also like to update everyone with essential information regarding caring for your horses and coaching during this unprecedented time.

Please note that this information is current as the 2nd of April 2020 and is subject to change when new information is announced from the Government.

Agistment Facilities

- If you own or operate an agistment, you may continue to operate your facility and treat and care for the animals on your agistment and maintain the facility.
- For agistment facilities with multiple horses, the facility must implement a roster system to ensure social distancing requirements can be maintained
- If you agist a horse at a property, you may continue to treat and care for your horse, INCLUDING exercising, ensuring you maintain proper physical distancing and hygiene practices. Please note, you should contact your agistment facility who may have enacted specific rules related to their facility. Equally, members may consider spelling their horse(s) at this time.
- If you are caring for your horse directly, only ride your horse within the boundaries of the property where it is kept. If you do choose to ride, take the necessary precautions to ensure your health and safety.
- Vets and other professional services (e.g. farriers) are permitted to attend whenever required while adhering to social distancing and hygiene requirements.

Travelling to care for your horse(s)

- Travel to care for your animals, including horses, is allowed. This includes providing your animals with food, water and anything else to meet your animal welfare responsibilities, including exercising.
- If you must leave your house to attend to your horse, take all necessary health measures, and comply with all the latest restrictions imposed by the Government.
- Only use grooming kit and tack which belongs to you, and do not share equipment with other people.
- For horses kept at a facility where feed or equipment may be stored centrally, please maintain a good personal hygiene practice and ensure common contact surfaces such as door handles are cleaned thoroughly and regularly.

Horse riding - am I allowed to ride my horse?

Yes we encourage you to still ride your horse for your wellbeing and your horses. If you do choose to ride, take the necessary precautions to ensure your health and safety. Keep it local; keep it low risk.

Upon advice from SAPOL and the Office of Rec, Sport & Racing, we have been advised that people may travel with their horses for lessons, recreational riding and medical requirements. The Minister for Sport, Corey Wingard advised us yesterday that horse riding is important for both mental and physical health, and that exercise is encouraged by the Department of Health at this difficult time.

Minister Wingard's recommendation was to "keep it local" and to abide by the social distancing guidelines in place.

Once again, we remind members that ESA is not creating or enforcing these guidelines. We are sharing the Government information as it comes to us.

Coaching

For many equestrians, their livelihood thrives by coaching. While the general recommendation is to stay and work from home where possible, the South Australian State Government has also stated that people may travel for their work if they are not able to remotely. Coaching can only take place at private facilities, including agistment facilities. However, it's to be conducted following the one person per 4 metre regulations, consistent with social distancing and personal hygiene regulations.

Coaches can use their own property facilities for instructing, meaning that those having lessons CAN travel to coaches, or coaches can travel to other private properties to continue working, again being consistent with the social distancing and personal hygiene.

Lastly, we would also like to note that the office of the Hon. David Littleproud MP, Minister for Agriculture, Drought and Emergency Management, said that the Federal Government considers the role of veterinarians essential to the agricultural sector and therefore to our nation's food security but also in protecting companion animals and our nation's wildlife, and has not put any restrictions on veterinarians other than the practice of social distancing and hygiene practices during this crisis.

Ride as many tests as you like, if doing more than 3 tests, these must be completed over a minimum of 2 days. Neat dress, no plaiting required. No hassle, no fuel costs!

Open on Nominate very soon – entries close 13 April and judging will take place on 19 April.
Results will be online via nominate on 19 April.

Dressage Judge Activities Update

Judges' Education Opportunities

Due to the COVID-19 restrictions, all Judge education seminars and workshop are on hold for the next couple of months.

1. G / F / E Seminar - 23 - 24th May with Felicity Yunken has been postponed. Hopefully to be held later in the year, date TBC.
2. D / E Seminar – 7th June, decision pending.
3. A / B / C Seminar – planned for November, date TBC
4. Young Horse – 29th November with Sue Cunningham.

Other News from the Equestrian Australia Dressage Judges Committee (EADJC)

As a result of the COVID-19 epidemic many equestrian events have been cancelled and many upcoming events are also likely to be cancelled, which will have a huge impact on those Judges currently going through the process to upgrade and are in the process of completing their pre-requisites.

As you are aware pre-requisites such as theory exams, shadow judging and sit-ins all have a tenure of two years (see Rule 12.22). In an effort to make the process easier for upgrading Judges in this time of crisis EADJC has agreed to relax the restriction on these abovementioned pre-requisites and indeed all pre-requisites, from the date they were completed during 2018 and 2019 will have a tenure of three years: ie. March 2018 to 31 March 2021 and June 2019 to 30 June 2022.

Pre-requisites completed in 2020 will be considered at an appropriate time if necessary.

Where practical exams have been cancelled as a result of the virus. JSCs should seek separate approval of EADJC (directed to the Secretary of EADJC) if this action affects the tenure of upgrading pre-requisites.

ESA Dressage Judges Committee

Upgrading Judges - Tenure of Pre Requisites - Extension

From Lesley Sullivan (Secretary EADJC):

As a result of the COVID-19 many Equestrian events have been cancelled and many upcoming events are also likely to be cancelled which will have a huge impact on those Judges who are currently going through the process to upgrade and are in the process of completing their pre-requisites.

As you are aware pre-requisites such as theory exams, shadow judging and sit-ins all have a tenure of two years (see rule 12.22). In an effort to make the process easier for upgrading judges in this time of crisis EADJC has agreed to relax the restriction on these above mentioned pre-requisites and all pre-requisites, from the date they were completed, during 2018 and 2019 will have a tenure of 3 years i.e. March 2018 to 31/3/21 and June 2019 to 30/6/22.

Pre-requisites completed in 2020 will be considered at an appropriate time if necessary.

Where practical exams have been cancelled as a result of the virus JSCs should seek separate approval of EADJC (directed to Secretary EADJC) if this action affects the tenure of upgrading pre-requisites.

It would be appreciated if you could pass this information on to all Judges going through the upgrading process.
