


show you better than I can tell you!" Well, during this time of the year, I want to show you that no matter what the question is, Jesus is the answer!


So the next time someone asks you who is Jesus, show them this! Have a wonderful Advent and Christmas season!




# Who is JESUS?

#### Faith, Hope and Belief

No more than at this time of year do we hear these words. Even in our tv commercials you will see examples of faith in our human-man. I did a little research to see exactly what some define the difference between faith, belief, and hope.

"Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. Faith lifts us up."

"Belief is a firmly held opinion or a strong confidence whereas faith is a strong religious belief. Belief is based on probability or chance whereas faith is not based on probability at all. Belief depends on proof whereas Faith does not. Belief is centered in faith whereas Faith is centered in trust."

Confused yet? Just to confuse you even further when we throw hope into the mix we get this:

"Without faith, hope is only a wish (powerless). But when we have hope in God, faith is powerful. A wish is hope without God. It's something we long for but it's generally not connected to God. <u>Biblical</u> hope has as it's foundation faith in God."

As we go through this holiday season our expectations of renewing our faith, hope and belief in the birth of the Christ child makes us more aware than ever of God's love for us and His salvation for the world.

Spend this time looking for the good in people, spread the good news of a baby's birth and remember as Christians

our FAITH in His love and our is more important God, our Belief of HOPE for our future than ever. JR
