DESCRIPTION: This is cool looking old Ben Pearson Javelina that is still in great condition. Walnut and White Holly riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. In lieu of tip overlays, Pearson inserted a wedge toward the end of the limbs to strengthen the tips (see pic on p. 3). This was a fairly common treatment for higher-end bows back in the day before tip overlays became the standard. Tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. There are a couple of scratches on edge of the riser (looks like there may have been some type of wrist sling at one time that caused the scratches) A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in fair condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$75 in 66, which translates to \$597 in 2020 inflation adjusted dollars.
