

Tombstone Rules

Print your first initial and last name on the cross.

Add your handicap, added to the course par. Blue tees 70, White tees 69 and Gold tees 64. Example Handicap 16 plus par 69 = 85 target score.

Carry your Tombstone with you.

When you run out of strokes, (handicap plus par rating) Place your Tombstone in the ground. Beside the green.

If your shot ends on a green, place your cross just off the fringe.

All putts must be holed out, no gimmies. Each stroke is important. It is another nail in your coffin.

After you have died you can still complete your round.

If you finish on the 18th you must be below your target score, or you are dead.

All players that haven't died by the end of the 18th hole, will return to the clubhouse with their cross.
