

"Christmas on Campus," a hilarious pet commercial and Harold the Angel visited too with a blues song and antics.


Whose Harold?

What you need:

- Work area with good ventilation
- Mason jar
- Clear glue that works
 on glass
- Paintbrush
- Glass stones
- Tealight candle
- Lighter
- Adult supervision

What you do:

- 1. Starting at the top of the jar, brush glue on a small section.
- 2. Press glass stones onto the glue in rows. Let dry.
- Continue gluing stones, in small sections, until the entire jar is covered.
 When dry, place a candle
- When dry, place a candle inside. Light with adult help.

Cindy is calling the new team, "G³" for Greg, Gary and Guy! They are working together to provide the visual dimension for each service.


