Hello Coaches and Parents

We are excited to have our competition on Saturday, April 17th. We are aware that COVID-19 causes things to be ever-changing, so we will keep you updated on any changes pertaining to our upcoming competition. We need to follow guidelines to ensure the safety of all our competitors, staff, and guests!! Having said this, we will be limiting the capacity of guests in order to comply with the number of people allowed in the gym and overall facility.

Here are some general rules....

- Parents, families, & guests will not be allowed to stay inside the gym. Everyone must station outdoors, in the school courtyard.
- One team will go inside at a time to compete. When going inside to compete, only 1
 accompanying guest per twirler will be allowed in the gym (we will let you know if
 things change to allow 2 guests per twirler). Once the routine is complete, twirler(s)
 and guest must exit the gym.
- Please feel free to videotape your twirler's routine(s) to share with other friends and family.
- Everyone must wear masks at all times. This includes the warm-up area inside. The twirlers may take their mask off when entering the floor to compete, but they must put them right back on before exiting the gym.
- Twirlers and their accompanying guest enter through the front door and exit through back door of the Gym.
- Temperature checks will be implemented upon initial check in. Once checked in, all
 guests and twirlers entering the gym will receive a wrist band, signifying their
 temperature has been checked and approved. Please wear this wrist band for the
 entirety of the day. Twirlers can wear their wrist bands on their ankle.
- Restrooms are for bathroom use only. There will be no changing inside the locker rooms. Changing tents/areas must be set up outside. Florida weather is hard to predict and there is always a very remote possibility of rain. Although much of the campus is undercover, it is a good idea to bring canopy tents for additional coverage. You can add some curtains/blankets to the sides if you want more closure.
- Teams will have designated areas in the courtyard to remain stationed during the day.
- Our concession stand will consist of pre-packaged, single-serving food and drink items. There will be no food preparation onsite. There are several restaurants near the school and outside food or drinks will be allowed in the courtyard, but not in the gym.
- We will have multiple hand sanitizer stations throughout the gym/surrounding areas and will request that twirlers & guests frequently wash their hands/use hand sanitizer throughout the day.

Coaches must inform all their team parents about the rules prior to the contest. As mentioned before, we will have designated areas outside where each group may set up their pop-up tents, canopies, and chairs. We ask that everyone please wear their masks in the courtyard too, unless their designated area or tents are arranged in such a manner that they are adequately distanced from other groups. When walking through common areas, masks must be worn.

Anyone in non-compliance will be asked to leave for they put us at risk of compromising the entire competition.

We are paying extra for special custodial staff, which will include a deep COVID sanitization prior to and immediately following our competition. They will also be on-campus the day of the event to wipe down frequently touched surfaces and to service the restrooms.

Procedures for the Competition:

Teams

Teams will run on a set-to-set system. We are encouraging teams/corps to have as few costume changes as possible. If they prefer, they can compete in practice clothes that are unified. The judges are aware this may occur. Competitors will only be allowed in the gym during the team's performance and will be asked to leave upon completion. This is to ensure social distancing in the stands and to limit the number of people in the gym at a time.

For teams, the size/number of team members will determine how many will get to go in the gym at the team's performance time. We are aiming to have two teams in line for warm up while one is on the floor. Only one team will be allowed in the atrium; pre-staging and getting temperature checks. As of right now, only one guest per twirler can go in gym to watch their team's performance. Team Coaches will be allowed in the gym as well. It is especially important for us to follow these guidelines to be able to host this event. Please ensure that all your team members and families know and understand these protocols ahead of time.

Individuals

The first 5 sets will be allowed in the gym first. After the first 5 sets have been checked in, the next 3 sets will check-in the atrium, where they will wait before going into the gym. Twirlers will be able to check in once they are 3 sets out. One guest will be allowed in the gym per individual twirler, as well as one accompanying coach. A twirler's guest/coach must be present upon check-in and have their temperature taken as well. ALL must wear masks. NO EXCEPTIONS. That's the rule for us to be able to have this contest. When seated in the gym to watch your twirler's event, guests must sit 6 feet apart from other parties.

We will be recommending that no costume changes take place for different solo events. We ask that all twirlers arrive in costume. We suggest having a changing tent outside if you desire a costume change.

We also plan to have a monitor-screen outside live-streaming the competition so that people in the courtyard can watch the team/individuals competing in the gym.

The line-ups will be posted on walls outside in several areas and the number performing at a given time will also be posted outside.

<u>Awards</u>

We are working on a website that will allow us to post all awards and placements as they are calculated. We will be posting Title events as fast as we can and will not be holding back any awards. When the division is complete and ready, we will post it. This will reduce congested areas within the gym.

Team Coaches/Directors, we will have a basket with all Team awards and scoresheets for you to pick up at the end of Teams.

There will not be an award table set-up. All Individual awards will be placed in a bag for the twirler and the parent/coach will be able to pick them up after the twirler's last event is posted.

I will be sending a coach's letter out closer to the day of the event with all of these details and more updates. The deadline is a hard deadline for entries and payment so that we can get everything organized, especially with planning for capacity limitations and transitions. We shouldn't have more than 75 people in the gym at one time.

I know this was a lot of info, but we want to give you have as much information as possible for your planning as well!
