Top 5 Market Animals & Breeding Heifers will be paid and all breed champions receive a prize (5 head in a breed must be present for breed prize).

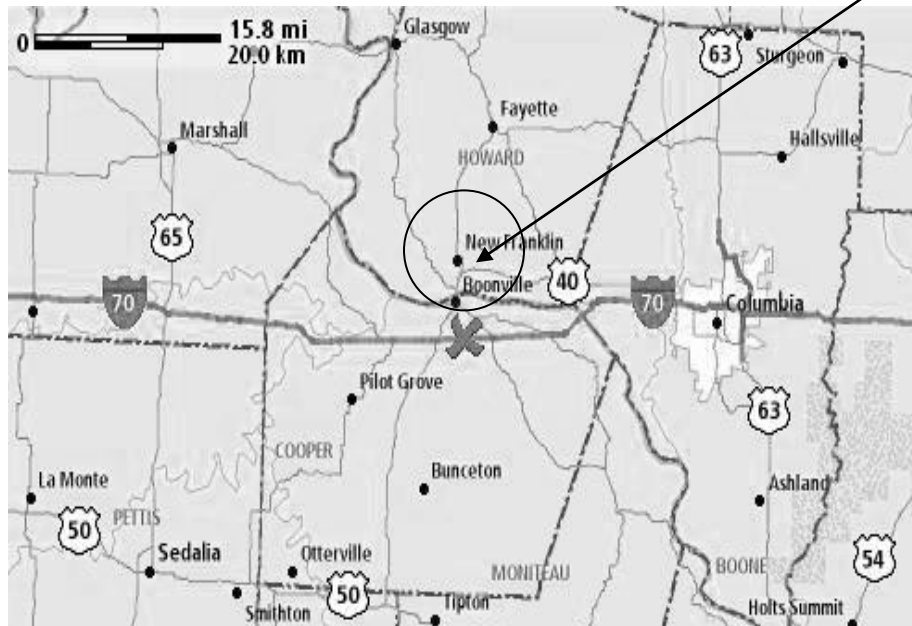

To get to the Cooper County Fairgrounds~~

From I-70 East:

Get off I-70 at Exit 101, go north on Hwy 5 to Old Hwy 40, and turn left. This is at the Rick Ball Auto Mall. Travel parallel along I-70 on Old Hwy 40 to first overpass. Turn left and cross over interstate, fairgrounds are on the left.

From I-70 West:

Get off I-70 at Exit 98, go north and cross over interstate. You will come to a T intersection, go east (right) and travel parallel along I-70 on Old Hwy 40 to the first overpass. Go south (right) and cross interstate, fairgrounds are on the left.

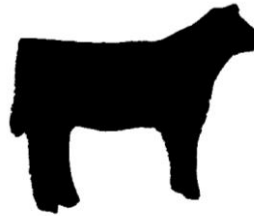

April 14th Open to all junior exhibitors 21 years of age and under. Breeding heifer show will start at 11:00 a.m., followed by the market animal show, and showmanship will immediately following the conclusion of the market animal show.

- Market animals and breeding heifers show by breed.
- Market Animals:
 - Must be born in 2018
 - Breed Classes will follow MCCA breed format.
 - Steers will show by weight, **NO REWEIGHS**
- Breeding Heifers:
 - Must not exceed 2 years of age by the day of the show.
 - All purebred heifers must have actual registration papers in hand at check in
 - All heifers will show by breed & age
 - Breed Classes will follow MCCA breed format
 - Heifers without registration papers will show as crossbred
 - Heifers may be shown in only one division (registered or crossbred)
- All animals must be owned and shown by the exhibitor
- No hemp, hair or hair-like materials or surgical alterations.
- Any and all animals will be subject to veterinary examination
- Portable generators are welcome
- Supply your own bedding
- Cattle may arrive any time after 6:00 p.m., Saturday, April 13, 2019
- The show management reserves the right to interpret the rules or make any decision regarding the show deemed necessary in the best interest of the event.
- All heifers will be released at the conclusion of the heifer show and all steers will be released at the conclusion of the steer show
- **Showmanship classes** will be held between the breeding heifer and market animal show. Showmanship classes are based on the exhibitor's birth date as of January 1, 2019. To show in the showmanship classes, you must have exhibited your animal in a regular class during the show that day. The showmanship divisions will be broke down as follows:
 - **Novice Division** - 7 and under
 - **Junior Division** - 8 - 11 years of age
 - **Intermediate Division** - 12 - 16 years of age
 - **Senior Division** - 17 - 21 years of age
