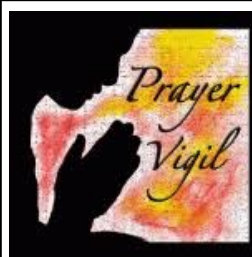
THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

The Sources of Morality (continued)

A good intention (for example, that of helping one's neighbor) does not make behavior that is intrinsically disordered, such as lying and calumny, good or just. The end does not justify the means. Thus the condemnation of an innocent person cannot be justified as a legitimate means of saving the nation. On the other had, an added bad intention (such as vainglory) makes an act evil that, in and of itself, can be good (such as almsgiving).

The *circumstances*, including the consequences, are secondary elements of a moral act. They contribute to increasing or diminishing the moral goodness or evil of human acts (for example, the amount of a theft). They can also diminish or increase the agents' responsibility (such as acting out of a fear of death.) Circumstances of themselves cannot change the moral quality of acts themselves; they can make neither good nor right an action that is in itself evil.

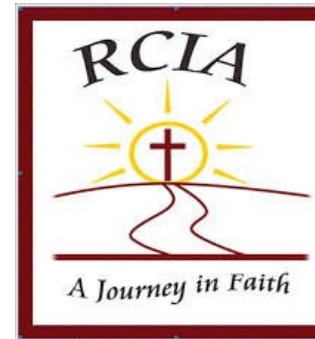
DAILY MASS?

SAINT MAXIMILIAN KOLBE Saint of the Day for August 14

"I don't know what's going to become of you!" How many parents have said that? Maximilian Mary Kolbe's reaction was, "I prayed very hard to Our Lady to tell me what would happen to me. She appeared, holding in her hands two crowns, one white, one red, one was for purity, the other for martyrdom. He chose them both. He spent three months in Auschwitz, suffering terrible beatings and humiliations. A prisoner had escaped. The commandant announced that 10 men would die. As they were being marched away to the starvation bunkers, Number 16670 dared to step from the line. "I would like to take that man's place. He has a wife and children." "Who are you?" "A priest." After being starved he was killed by injection. Father Kolbe's death was not a sudden, last-minute act of heroism. His whole life had been a preparation. His holiness was a limitless, passionate desire to convert the whole world to God. And his beloved Immaculata was his inspiration.
