Plant operator monthly flow meter report was presented to the board.

- ➢ Variable Frequency Drive has been replaced and operating efficiently.
- Ram Industries removed all debris in tanks and reattached the float to the pump station wall.
- Bridgeway Power preformed a semi-annual maintenance on the back-up generator, load test preformed and passed. After five years Bridgeway Power is recommending that CMSA replace the batteries in the back-up system, currently the batteries are seven years old, triple charger on the batteries, generator started in failed condition.
- MMH006-Mountain Road will be returned to Data Gator on Tuesday February 21st, 2012 for recalibration: CMSA Chairman requested a 24 hour factory test before returning to CMSA.
