There being a quorum, Mayor Simmons called the meeting of the Vienna City Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Hill made a motion to Approve the Omnibus Consent Agenda consisting of the June 5, 2019 Council Meeting Minutes and the Warrant (\$25,387.20). Alderman Riddle seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Simmons presented a plaque to Cheryl Myrick in appreciation for her 4 years of service as Alderwoman Ward 3. Myrick recently resigned due to relocation out of her ward.

Jay Boyd with Shawnee Trails E-Bike rentals was present to request permission to rent out motorized bikes at the city park on the weekends through October. Boyd said the bikes were motorized but did not go over 20 mph. Council had discussion and were in consent to allow the rentals. Council directed Boyd to first contact the Tunnel Hill trail Supt to verify motorized bikes

would be allowed on the trail and also that Boyd fill out a vendor application and pay said fee at city hall.

Mike Brown, Roy Walker Communications was present to review a proposal for two Whelen 800-Watt tornado siren systems. Brown answered numerous questions from council members on the siren system and also mentioned a lease purchase option. Council continued discussion and were in agreement further information was needed as well as the lease option looked into. Alderman Tuey said he would be in contact with Southern Five to discuss a possible USDA grant to help with funds.

Alderman Racey made a motion to Authorize and Approve Ordinance 19-03, An Ordinance Approving Prevailing Wage Rates for the City of Vienna. The motion was seconded by Alderman Owen. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Owen made a motion to Authorize and Approve Resolution 19-07, A Resolution in Accordance with the State of Illinois laws in connection with a grant from the Abandoned Residential Property Municipal Relief Program issued to the City of Vienna by the IL Housing Development Authority. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hill. All in favor, Motion carried.

Alderman Racey made a motion to Authorize and Approve Officer's Certificate and Certificate of Incumbency in Connection with the Abandoned Residential Property Municipal Relief Program. The motion was seconded by Alderman Riddle. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Hill made a motion to table agenda item #10 on the purchase of installing fencing around the police department firing range. Motion was seconded by Alderman Riddle. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Racey made a motion to Authorize and Approve \$250.00 (Community Funds) for DJ expenses/Heath Holloman at the city's Fourth of July even to be held on July 5th. Alderman Tuey seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

CITY ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS

Clerk Wright said the date for the 2019 Fiscal Year audit was tentatively set for July 15th. Wright also said the two new swings that were purchased for the city park had been delivered and were installed by City Supt. Wright also said emergency repairs were made to the city's backhoe, replacement of hydraulic pump (\$800.00 General Funds).

Wright informed council the Illinois Municipal League had contacted city hall and was interested in quoting the city's general insurance for December, 2019-2020.

Police Chief Miller said he contacted former county officer Jeff Jordan about assisting with school security for the 2019-2020 school year. Miller also said the recent Eagle Scout project presented to council by Alex Miller was officially approved by the Eagle Scout board of review.

As there was no further business to discuss, Alderman Owen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Riddle. Motion Carried, all in favor.

Mayor Simmons declared the meeting adjourned at 7:51 p.m.
