COVID/Visitation Update

Greetings from Midway Nursing Home!

At the present time there no new COVID positive cases for residents or staff and all residents and staff remain asymptomatic.

Our precautionary quarantine period ends on Monday, February 22nd, and window visits will resume on Tuesday, February 23rd. Should any resident or staff test positive at any time, visitation will again be put on “pause”.

Window visits are weather permitting, by appointment only, and on a first come first serve basis. Window visits may be converted to an in-person visit if the weather is inclement.

All visitors are screened upon arrival and must present a photo ID and proof of a negative COVID PCR test result for a test taken within 7 days of their scheduled visit. Rapid test results are not accepted. We recommend that you schedule your visit at Midway NH **prior to** being tested to ensure that your COVID PCR test is done within 7 days of your scheduled visit.

Visits are limited to 2 people per resident session and all visitors must be age 18 or older. While on Midway NH premises, face masks must always be worn, and 6 feet social distancing must always be maintained.

Visit sessions are 30 minutes long and are Monday thru Friday from 10:30AM to 11:00AM and from 1:30PM to 2:00PM.

Our visitation schedule is as follows:

Monday	=	4 th floor
Tuesday	=	5 th floor
Wednesday	=	6 th floor
Thursday	=	3 rd floor
Friday	=	2 nd floor

Please note that if any visitor fails to adhere to Midway’s visiting protocols, per NYSDOH guidelines they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic.
