

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-07-03

TO DIRECT THE FINANCE OFFICER TO FILE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR A SCHEDULE OF APPROPRIATION FOR 2016-2017 AND REQUEST THE AUDITOR PLACE THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 CHANNEL MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT ON THE TAX ROLL AND BE AFFIXED ACCORDINGLY.

WHEREAS, Salton Community Services District has been requested by the Imperial County Auditor, in compliance with the requirements of Section 29040 of the Government Code of the State of California, to file an itemized estimate of anticipated channel maintenance assessments with reference to the District's Channel Maintenance Fund for the fiscal year 2016-2017 and,

WHEREAS, it is desired to establish channel maintenance assessments on hereinafter described properties;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the finance officer of the District is hereby authorized and directed to file with the Imperial County Auditor said itemized estimate of anticipated expenditures from the Channel Maintenance Fund for the fiscal year 2016-2017.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Channel Maintenance assessment is set for the following tracts:

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, this Channel Maintenance Assessment is hereby placed on the tax rolls.


