It is goal of H4G to provide safe, comfortable and free transportation to children and youths in the community as part of our ministry. We take the safety of your student very seriously. With the above goal in mind, the following rules have been established for the benefit of all:

Van Rules & Expectations:

1. Stay facing forward and buckled until the van(s) park.
2. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
3. No swearing or shouting.
4. No drinks, food, or backpacks (without driver consent)
5. Follow the directions the first time (includes attitude and behavior).

**Consequences:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – One week van / programming suspension
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Two week van suspension
- 4<sup>th</sup> Offense – Three month van suspension
- 5<sup>th</sup> Offense – 1 Year van suspension

All parents / guardians must agree to these expectations. Consequences are subject to the driver’s discretion and a parent will be notified after a second offense.

**HOPE FOR GENERATIONS PROGRAMMING INCLUDES:**

- Regular mentoring activities for youth on Tuesday evenings.
- Bible Club program primarily for elementary aged children on Thursday evenings.
- Other fun activities and programs as scheduled!
