Financial Overview

- The Parking Authority had revenue in August 2022 of \$38,243. This is \$2,484 lower than August 2021. Total expenses were \$37,878. A decrease of \$1,648 compared to the previous year. Net revenue was \$365. A decrease of \$836 compared to August 2021.
 - Outstanding payables as of 09/22/22 was \$39,369 plus \$134,679 of employer's pension contribution.
 - Total loan balances as of 09/22/2022 was \$33,739 plus \$450,000 pending for NJT.

YTD Revenue as of August 2022 was \$411,589. An increase of \$18,707 compared to 2021. YTD Expenses were \$277,470 a decrease of \$1,509 compared to 2021. YTD Net Revenue was \$134,119. An increase of \$20,216 compared to 2021 and a decrease of \$23,753 compared to 2019, pre pandemic.

- The Park and Ride had revenue in August 2022 of \$15,328. This is \$8,746 higher than August 2021. Total Expenses were \$17,445. An increase of \$247 compared to 2021. Net revenue was \$(2,117). An Increase of \$8,499 compared to August 2021
 - Outstanding payables as of 08/25/2022 was \$224,242
 - General payables was \$6,945
 - NJT Draw \$108,000
 - Due to Parking Authority \$217,297

YTD Revenue as of August 2022 was \$117,864. An increase of \$40,059 compared to 2021. YTD Expenses were \$144,667 an increase of \$8,668 compared to 2012. YTD Net Revenue was \$(35, 471) an improvement of \$31,390 compared to 2021 and a decrease of \$70,457 compared to 2019, pre pandemic.

- NJT Status: Pending No Update
- Redevelopment Status/Land Sale: Joe Coronato, Jr., Legal Counsel for the Authority
 presented updated terms for the land sale contract with the Township for the sale of the
 parking lot (Lot H). The Commissioners agreed to the terms and to having \$500,000
 escrowed with Coronato Law, encumbered for New Jersey Transit. The remaining balance
 will be used for Pension Payables and Emergency funds as deemed by the Board of
 Commissioners.

• Maintenance Building Clean Up: Submittal for the request of record destruction has been returned as a large part of records marked for destruction require an Auditor's signature. Pam Piner has reached out to the Authority's Auditing company to have them approved the required documents, She is waiting to hear back on the proper procedure.

New Business

• Park and Ride Elimination: Pam Piner, TRPA Director provided a financial analysis to the Board of Commissioners showing the Parking Authority's financial position with and without the Park and Ride. Based on the current financial information, it would not be in the best interest of either party to terminate the current relationship. However, it is imperative to negotiate new contracts for both NJT Bus Ticket sales and for the operation of the Park and Ride including an increase in the daily parking rate. The current parking rate of \$2.00 has not increased in over 20 years and is no longer able to cover current expenses.
