Catholic Halloween?

"Hallow" is a word that means "Holy". We even say it in the Our Father- "hallowed be thy name". We celebrate All Saints' Day on November 1st. This day can also be called "All Hallows Day" because it's the day about all the Holy people- the Saints. The day before All Saints' Day is called "All Hallows Eve", just like the day before Christmas is called "Christmas Eve". Over time, people just started saying "Halloween" instead of "All Hallows Eve". – Lacy from Catholic Icing

November 2nd is also when we celebrate All Soul's Day. The entire month of November is dedicated to remembering those who have died.

Halloween is full of ghoulish delights, tricks and treats, screams and giggles. But it is important to remember the great feast day that we are anticipating on All Hallows Eve.

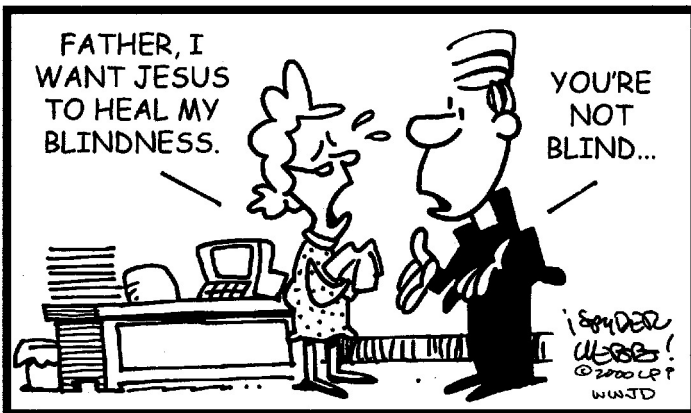
