
## **COD Newsworthy News**



# Corvette Racing 2023



Today Chevrolet announced the plan for Corvette Racing in 2023. One Corvette C8.R will run the full season in IMSA and one will run the full season in WEC. The IMSA team will look nearly identical to this year's, with Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor contesting all of the races. Tommy Milner will join them for the long events - Daytona, Sebring and Petit Le Mans. Because there will no longer be a GTE PRO class in WEC for full-factory teams with all-pro driver lineups the WEC entry will compete in GTE AM with one full-pro driver (Nicky Catsburg), one "Bronze" rated driver (Ben Keating) and one Bronze or Silver driver (to be named later). As anyone who has followed top-level sports car racing in recent years knows, Ben Keating is one of, if not the, best Bronze driver in the world with multiple championships and victories at all the top races, including Le Mans, Sebring, and Daytona. He, Nicky and their co-driver will be highly competitive in next year's WEC races. #### **COD's second charity**



Many of these animals need medical care and since the DHS does not receive any government funding, they are very grateful for donations. Cindy told us two recent animal stories. In the first case, 12 cats and kittens were left on the DHS doorstep in a wire cage. Several of these felines were in desperate need of care. The DHS took them in and looked after them even though it is very inconvenient to have animals left outside the shelter.

Second story involved a small breed puppy that had been found on the side of the road. It was young and if the puppy had not been turned into the shelter by a stranger, it would probably not have survived the night. This puppy will now find a very good home.

The DHS also takes in all kinds of small animals including rabbits, gerbils, domestic rats etc.

Cindy was very thankful to receive our Club cheque of \$500.00 She posed for pictures with President Anne and Susan and Jann L., who both did a lot of work to make the presentation of donated goods a memorable experience.

#### WANTED: CAPTAIN for 'ONTARIO CARAVAN 2024'



In August of 2024, the National Corvette Museum (NCM) will celebrate the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of its opening! The NCM has grown over the years and currently boasts a representative collection of every Corvette built. Nowhere else will you see the *only surviving 1983 Corvette!!* 

To celebrate this special anniversary occasion, Ontario Corvette owners are invited to participate in a Caravan - often referred to as the world's largest moving automotive event - traveling together to the home of the Corvette. Bowling Green, Kentucky is the destination, arriving in time for the museum festivities to begin. The dates are Thursday, August 29 through Saturday, August 31, 2024.

In order to arrive in Bowling Green together, Ontario needs a Caravan Captain to lead us! An event such as this requires planning and coordinating. Will that be you and your team?

The Caravan Captain must be a National Corvette Museum member. If you're not already an NCM member, signing up is easy. Log on to the NCM website at <a href="https://www.corvettemuseum.org">www.corvettemuseum.org</a>, select 'membership' from the dropdown box, select 'Become a Member' and follow the steps.

Task highlights to be carried out by the Caravan Captain and the ON organizing team are:

- Choose an organizing committee treasurer, co-captain, and others as required (such as regional representatives, ON Caravan shirts, media, sponsorship coordinators)
- o Have the treasurer set up dual signatory bank accounts in both Canadian and US funds.
- o Set up a specific ON Caravan email account and ON Caravan Facebook page
- Sign a contract to reserve hotel accommodation in Bowling Green KY for at least 50 rooms.
   Request complementary accommodation for the ON Captain in return for the large number of rooms being booked.
- Organize the route from ON to Bowling Green, deciding where best to cross the border. (Note: Unless the captain is familiar with the choice of routes from Ontario to Bowling Green, it is helpful to drive the route and take note of the possible overnight stops along the way.)
- Sign a contract to reserve hotels for the overnight stops on the route to Bowling Green. Request complementary rooms for the ON Captain in return for the large number of rooms being booked.
- Compose and manage the ON webpage for the NCM website including local contact data, ON
  registration sheet with payment method and amount (~\$25/car) and submit to NCM for posting.
   Send updates to the Museum as necessary.
- o Post the above information on the ON Caravan Facebook page. Update as required.
- Attend twice-yearly 'Caravan Captains' meetings at the NCM if able, or send an alternate to represent the ON Caravan team.
- Participate in NCM Caravan fund-raising efforts by purchasing items for re-sale to ON Corvette drivers - window clings, flags etc.
- Choose a convenient departure point from ON which has parking and washrooms for all ON Caravan participants
- o Other tasks to be completed or delegated as / when required.




