Trinity UCC Council Notes August 14, 2017 7pm

Council President Ed Gahler called the meeting to order. Present were Pastor Kyle, Ed, Robin Hansen, Dan Mathews, Steve Turnow, Marty Hoeft, Jim Buhro, Connie Gahler, Dan Gahler, John Bast, and Nyla Denman. Absent were Rhonda Mahaney, Anna Diekman, and Veronica McMonigal

Pastor Kyle read a devotional about "The Importance of Light" and then followed with a prayer.

The July council meeting notes were read and motion to accept secretarial report made by Nyla; seconded by Robin. Motion carried. Time off request from Rhonda for 8/21-8/24 as well as coming in late on 8/25 discussed and approved.

Financial secretary report was reviewed and discussion was held regarding Audit Committee review and future suggestions. Motion made by Robin to accept the minutes as read and also to allow for potential changes to be made regarding deposit procedures and recordings if advised per Audit Committee suggestions, if any. Seconded by Jim. Motion carried.


