Village Hall Development update	Presentation by task group of options considered regarding the development and modernisation of the village hall; outline designs of options considered; implications. Three options had been considered in detail by the task group - 1. new build - 2. extensive refurbishment - 3. modernisation and refurbishment on a more modest scale	

£4000 has been spent on planning to date in line with the agreement at the public meeting that this sum could be invested in research and planning of feasible options. It was agreed that the third option was the only realistic way forward given outline costings of these options.
Next steps considered – - The need for a Parish Plan that would place these developments in a wider context; - following on from that a detailed business plan for redevelopment would be needed that would demonstrate sustainability; - it would then require applications for grant funding to support the funding of the development.
Agreed that the plans for modernisation and a more modest refurbishment should be presented to a village meeting which would be supported by Barbara Pond of Gloucestershire Rural Community Council. This would be an opportunity for consultation with the village community on this proposal to determine whether the village could support this as a way forward.
Grateful thanks were expressed to Keith Russell, Neil Vincent, Vanessa Gatford and Ian Adstock, who had all given their time, energies and skills to progress these proposals. This was hugely appreciated by all present.
