FALL CLEAN UP

Kamsack Fall Clean Up runs until **October 14th**.

During Fall Cleanup, Town Staff collect compostable yard waste throughout town; including grass clippings, leaves, branches and garden refuse.

- Branches must be cut to a reasonable length, roughly 3 to 4 feet, and should not be tied together.
 - Leaves should be in clear plastic bags.
 - Grass clippings do not need to be bagged.

To participate, simply place your compostable yard waste by your back property line, if your property borders a back alley. Otherwise, please place yard waste by your front property line. Staff will **NOT** pick up household waste, metal, furniture, appliances or construction debris. To learn more, please phone Town Office at (306) 542-2155

Landfill FAQ's

- Tickets for the landfill must be purchased at Town Office. Tickets are not available at the Landfill.
- Carload \$5; Utility Trailer \$10; Truck \$15
- Additional \$5 per item charge for appliances and furniture
- No hazardous materials accepted
- Grass, leaves and branches are free
- Shingle disposal fee = \$5.60 per approx. bundle
