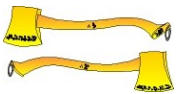
The Remembrance and Renewal Service is an Obligatory Function for all Scottish Rite Masons.

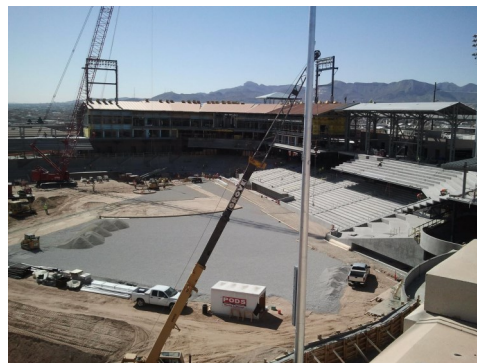
