Victoria Regan is a former United States Latin Champion, North American and U.S. 10 Dance Champion, five-time Canadian Ballroom and Latin Dance Champion, and is a British Latin Finalist.

Her professional memberships include AEA, SAG, and AFTRA. Victoria is a tap examiner for the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing in the U.S. and is on the National Dance Board of Arthur Murray International.

Victoria holds a fellowship degree in the Theatre Arts branch and a Licentiate degree in the Ballroom, Latin, and American Style branches. She serves on the nominating committee for the National Museum of Dance's C.V. Whitney Hall of Fame.

She has her own series of Ballroom Dance tapes titled "You Can Dance".

Ms. Regan joined the faculty of the Broadway Theatre Project in 2007 and now acts as a Guest Artist yearly.

Her Broadway credits include the original cast of *42nd Street*, directed by Gower Champion, and Tommy Tune's *Grand Hotel*. Victoria played the leading role of Grushinskaya in *Grand Hotel* and LaFleur in the musical *Nine* in Naples, Florida.

Victoria can be seen in the films *A Chorus Line* and *Annie*.

She has performed in concerts featuring the music and lyrics of George Gershwin, Cole Porter, and others.

Much of her time is spent coaching professional and amateur competitors and judging major competitions worldwide.
