# Waste Management procedures for residents in Sections 1, 2, 3

# **COLLECTION DAYS**

• Collection days are Mondays (trash) and Thursdays (trash and recycle).

The 96-gallon waste cart with green lid will be used for our normal trash and grass clipping bags. Loose trash bags or bags left by yard maintenance workers will no longer be picked up by the automated collection trucks unless they are inside the green carts. If there are too many loose bags to fit in the cart on normal collection days, they will be picked up on the bulk service day.

# **BULK SERVICE DAY**

- Bulk Service day is the second Thursday of each month.
- Acceptable Bulk Items:

Acceptable bulk items include broken down and bundled moving boxes, old furniture, bagged grass clippings, leaves, branches and tree trimmings. Branches and tree trimmings that are tied and bundled should be no more than three inches (3") in diameter and four feet (4') in length and weighing no more than forty to fifty (40-50) pounds.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- Your service carts must be placed at the curb to be serviced.
- Place carts 4 feet from obstructions (such as mailboxes and cars) and within 1 foot from the curb.
- Keep area around the service cart clear for easy access by collection truck.

Recycle bottles, cans, paper and cardboard (use waste cart with yellow lid).

- Keep food and liquid out of your recycling.
- No loose plastic bags.
- No bagged recyclables.

Please remember: In order to keep our neighborhood looking its best, do not put the carts or bulk items out to the curb for pickup before 5 pm on the day before pickup is scheduled.

# Best Trash procedures for residents in Section 4

## **COLLECTION DAYS**

• Collection days are Mondays (trash/recycle) and Thursdays (trash).

You may use trash cans that are between 30 to 50 gallons in size.

For recycle items use green barrel with black lid.

# **BULK SERVICE DAY**

- Bulk Service is offered each trash service day.
- · Acceptable Bulk Items:

Acceptable bulk items include broken down and bundled moving boxes, old furniture bagged grass clippings, leaves. branches and tree trimmings. Branches and tree trimmings that are tied and bundled should be no more than three inches (3") in diameter and four feet (4') in length and weighing no more than forty to fifty (40-50) pounds.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Your trash cans must be placed at the curb to be serviced.

Excluded Bulk Items: Dirt, mulch, rocks, bricks, tile, concrete (cement), tires, batteries, motor oil, cooking oil, construction debris. For additional information on waste pick up, please go to
