Update on CTS 2024 Projects:

<u>New Boiler System/Hot Water Heater</u> – In April a new boiler and hot water heater was installed. Special thanks to Herb Siefert and Dave Schmidt for reviewing the six different vendor bids and providing a recommendation for Pastor and me that was then passed along to the church council for approval. Herb was also on location while the vendor installed the new boiler and hot water heater.

<u>Rubber Pellets in the Swing Set Area</u> - Thanks to Dave McGrath for helping me spread out a pallet of rubber pellets in the swing set area on the east end of the parking lot. Project completed May 11.

<u>Landscape Committee</u> —Thanks to Beth Melvold, Carol Matson, Jann Clark and Sarah Wolff who got together at the suggestion of Pastor Gwen to make some recommendations for landscaping around the south and west ends of the church building. Much of the landscaping was overgrown, weed infested and no longer conducive for maintenance by our church congregation. The plan is to:

1) remove all existing bushes, plants and gravel around the south and west ends of the building; 2) plant new bushes in a much smaller area on each side of the sidewalk entering the building; 3) plant grass in the remaining areas to match the north and east sides of the building.

On May 15, Scott Carpenter, Dave McGrath and I spent the better part of a working day tearing out the old landscaping and removing the gravel around the building. Dave Schmidt provided assistance during the critical part of the early morning plant tear out. Thanks to Scott for use of his tractor and his trailer for hauling away materials. Also thanks to Dave and Dave for assisting in the project. The landscape vendor should complete the project in the next couple of months.

<u>Fellowship Hall Flooring and Painting</u> – The Fellowship Hall flooring is 35 years old. The Plan is to replace the flooring and paint Fellowship Hall including the two rooms used for storage and meetings. Beth Melvold sent out a church wide survey on flooring options back in March. Thanks to Beth for organizing and gathering of information to date. Carol, Jann and Sarah (along with Beth) have also been involved in this project. We are currently narrowing down the option choices for flooring and looking for a vendor to paint the room.

<u>Electrical Work and Improved Lighting</u> – The plan is to replace some of the existing electrical ballasts with LED lighting in Fellowship Hall, the hallway and offices. We believe this will provide better lighting and reduce electrical costs. Also, RB Melvold is doing some background work on how to make lighting improvements inside the sanctuary. Thank you RB for taking the lead on this item. More to come...

<u>New Office Computer</u> – At the May meeting, the Church Council authorized the replacement of the office computer which is outdated and painstakingly slow when working and installing updates. Thanks to Paul Miller for his expertise in recommending a new computer and also his willingness to take the lead and transfer over the data.

<u>Exterior Painting</u> – The exterior of the church building is in need of painting. During our landscape demolition we noticed some siding and trim boards need attention before we embark on a painting of the entire building. We will need to pause on this item to first address the siding and trim boards.
