What to bring:

- **Sleeping Bag, extra pillows (if needed), PJ's, blankets if needed**
- Appropriate warm weather clothes and shoes *

- Swim Suit ** (We are not allowed to enter the water except during baptisms, so don't plan on swimming!)
- Toiletries
- **Sunscreen**
- Bible
- Any necessary medications
- Extra spending money for souvenirs, snacks (some snacks will be provided)

- **Monday, July 15th, 2019**

- **Tuesday, July 16th, 2019**
 - We'll take a trip to the Tillamook Cheese Factory for cheese samples and ice cream – bring extra money for souvenirs, and cameras for pictures. Afterwards, we'll visit the animals at the Blue Heron Cheese Factory, and then head home for lunch and beach time.
