

SCCC Application Guidelines & Eligibility – Jury Session on Thursday, September 21, 2017

Residency: application is open to any craft artisan who resides and regularly pursues his or her craft on Cape Cod, the South Shore, or the South Coast of Massachusetts and the counties of Nantucket and Dukes. Please note: paying taxes on Cape Cod properties does not automatically make one eligible.

Fine Craft Only: Submissions representing the finest quality craftsmanship are welcome. The Society seeks professional crafters who focus on excellence in their craft, create original work and have developed a unique style or voice. All craft must be handmade by the applicant.

Not acceptable: paintings, prints, photography, assembled jewelry (ie. beading, etc.), dried or silk flower arrangements, goods created from kits, parts or patterns, pottery or glass made from pre-manufactured molds, embellished commercial objects or clothing, factory made items, t-shirts, baked goods, decorative painting or any item that is not handmade by the applicant.

Membership: There is a \$40 annual membership fee and a separate booth fee (10x10 spot) to participate in the 3-day festival in August. Only juried members can participate in the fair scheduled annually in August.

Two Step Jury Process

1. Part One – Paper Application

Submit your completed application, 4 photos of your work and one booth photo, and a \$20 non-refundable application fee. Applications are due on September 11, 2017.

2. Part Two – Jury Session on September 21, 2017

Please prepare and deliver at least **FIVE** samples of your work (**labeled with title/description and price**) that best represent the range of items you would like to sell at the annual craft fair in August. Current Society members in your medium will review and jury work. The jurors will consider workmanship, quality, design, originality, use of materials, price points and presentation. **Applicants may not be present for the jury process.**

- a. You may set up your work samples on **September 21, 2017 between 5:00 and 5:30pm**. The delivery location is the Cultural Center of Cape Cod, 307 Old Main Street, South Yarmouth, MA. A table will be provided and your set up must be completed by 5:30pm. You must return at 7:00pm, the same evening, to collect your work following the jury meeting.

Notifications: Applicants will receive written notification with jury decision by US mail within one week.
