

**VILLAGE OF DRYDEN  
BUDGET HEARING & SPECIAL MEETING  
LAMB MEMORIAL BUILDING  
FEBRUARY 9th, 2010**

President Betcher called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Council Members present were: Kelso, Yezak, Nash, Roszczewski, Quail and Franz

Motions passed to: approve an increase in the minimum sewer rate to \$20.25 per first 6000 gallons of usage and to approve an increase in minimum water rate to \$18.00 per first 6000 gallons of usage, all other water/sewer usage rates and user fees are left unchanged, to approve Village paid holidays that fall on a scheduled work day for the Clerk and Treasurer, to adopt the 2010/2011 Village and Downtown Development Authority Budget as presented, to amend the Village of Dryden Investment Policy to include the following financial institutions as depositories of Village funds, PCN Bank, Private Bank and 5/3 Bank.

Council discussed that it will be necessary to either utilize fund balance, reduce the 2010/2011 General Fund Budget and/or increase the 2010 millage rate due to the 11% reduction in State Revenue Sharing and the proposed decrease in the 2010 Property Tax Revenue.
