

BOATING RULES AND REGULATIONS – Privately Owned Boats

The Waters lakes are designed for use by **non-gas powered boats**. Assembly Members are allowed to launch privately owned boats in Lake Cameron and use their electric motors so long as the following guidelines are met:

1. All Members with boats being used on The Waters lakes must obtain general liability insurance and provide evidence of such insurance to The Waters Assembly prior to use on Lake Cameron. At the time of registration, the Member must provide a certificate of insurance establishing that the operation of the boat is covered by a liability insurance policy with a combined single limit of at least \$100,000 per occurrence for bodily personal injury, including death and property damage coverage. The policy shall provide that The Assembly shall be given at least ten (10) days prior written notice to the non-renewal, lapse, cancellation, or termination of the policy. Additionally, by completing the Registration Form, the Member covenants and agrees to maintain this coverage as long as the boat is operated in The Waters. **The Waters Assembly, Inc., New Waters, LLC, and New Waters Realty Company, LLC, shall be named as a certificate holder** on any policy.
2. Members requesting a permit to operate a privately-owned boat on Lake Cameron must complete a Boat Registration Form.
3. Once proof of insurance and a Boat Registration Form is provided and accepted by The Assembly, the Member will receive a Waters Boat Permit evidencing proof of insurance and approval to operate the Member's boat on Lake Cameron. The Waters lakes are privately owned and any boat without a valid permit sticker will not be allowed and will be towed without notice, at the owner's expense.
4. An annual registration fee (\$25.00) must be paid by the Member registering his/her boat. Any additional future costs encountered and determined by the Assembly's Board of Directors to be relative to authorized boat operation will be borne equally by all registered boat owners. Members who qualify for a Waters Boat Permit will be provided with a key to the temporary boat launching area. This area is only for Waters Members permitted boats (Valid Permits). Any other boats or other items in the temporary boat launching area will be towed without notice, at the owner's expense. Members found giving and/or loaning Member's boat launch key to a non-Member (non-resident) will lose their permit, key and rights to use the lake.
5. The temporary boat launching area is approved for storing of Waters permitted boats only. Any non-Waters permitted boats or any other items that remain in the temporary boat launching area without a permit will be towed without notice, at the owner's expense. At some point, in the near future, the temporary boat launching area will be only for boat launching and will no longer be available for storage. Management is evaluating possible options for boat storage but cannot ensure that storage space will be available. In that event, owners will be required to store boats elsewhere.
6. Only boats with a valid Waters Boat Permit will be allowed to operate on Lake Cameron.
7. No jet skis, wave runners, Seadoos or other types of motorized personal watercraft shall be used on the lakes.
8. Boats powered by gasoline, petroleum, or other engines that create excessive noise, speed, or exhaust are not permitted.
9. Members should have an emergency whistle and cell phone when on The Waters Lakes.

10. Boats, boat trailers, or other recreational vehicles, if stored at private residents, must be stored in a covered carport or garage.
11. Privately owned boats may only be stored at private residences (as set forth in the Covenants and Restrictions for The Waters Assembly) or temporary boat launching area, and cannot be moored anywhere else on the lake.

Watercraft size restrictions do exist – contact The Assembly Management for further information.
